
## **Innovation and Skills Projects**


#### **InnovFin Guarantees and Equity**

Under InnovFin, the EIF provides guarantees to financial institutions that will, in turn, provide loans to **innovative** companies (*InnovFin SME Guarantee*, or *SMEG*), or through making equity investments and co-investments, to, or alongside, funds focusing on **innovative** companies in their pre-seed, seed and startup phases (*InnovFin Equity*). InnovFin is a joint EIB Group and EC initiative under Horizon 2020, the EU research programme for 2014-2020.

#### 2018 Highlights

- More than 15,000 innovative companies supported
- A record breaking number of Venture Capital transactions to allow new funds to be raised and existing funds to grow 96 (EUR 1.6bn)
- EUR 12bn of commitments deployed by the EIF through a network of 398 fund managers

#### THE HUB IN NUMBERS:

- Since its launch in 2015, the Advisory Hub has received 1,102 requests, including 416 in 2018.
   Of which, the hub has given guidance to more than 900 companies and public bodies across the European Union.
- The Hub has received 21 requests from the Iberian Peninsula during 2018.





Financing of the RDI investment programme carried out by the Spanish Secretary of State for RDI as part of a nation-wide strategy to improve Spanish innovation and

competitiveness. Beneficiaries will be public research infrastructures and organizations across Spain as well as researchers and research institutions.

The WindFloat project covers the

design and installation of a 25MW floating offshore wind farm c.20km off the coast of Portugal, 85-100m deep. It will comprise 3 floating substructures with recently developed wind turbines of the 8.4MW class. The project would also include and export cable sections to a fixed sub-sea cable connection that is to be installed and operated by the transmission system operator.

#### **Smart Finance for Smart Buildings (SFSB)**

SFSB is an EU-wide initiative aiming to finance energy efficiency projects in buildings. The Hub undertook initial pilot actions in France. Malta. Romania, and Spain. It also conducting a study on ratings for loans devoted to energy efficiency projects and has developed a guidance note for **Energy Performance Contracts** for public buildings renovation through ESCOs (Energy Service Companies)
