SANFORD, April 21. (Special)—Ralph B. Emery, 52, prominent in the business, civic and fraternal associations of Sanford and Springvale, died late Monday night at Henrietta D. Goodall Memorial Hospital. He had been ill five weeks.

Emery, who was born in Sanford, was graduated from the Abbott School, Farmington, in 1908, received his BS Degree from Wentworth Institute in Boston in 1915, and a degree from the University of New Hampshire in 1920.

He was a member of the Alpha Tau Omega Fraternity and the Phi Sigma and Alpha Zeta honorary societies.
