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Employment and Immigration Options

- On-Campus Employment
- Curricular Practical Training (CPT)
- Optional Practical Training (OPT)
- H-1B — Specialty Occupation
- TN — NAFTA professional
- Employment Permanent Residence
- US Citizen Spouse Permanent Residence

On-Campus Employment

- Permitted as part of F-1 status
- No need for SEVIS/USCIS authorization
- HR letter for social security number
- 20 hours/week or less while in session
- See Career Services about Work Study positions

Curricular Practical Training (CPT)

- Employment must be related to program
- Valid F-1 status for one full academic year
- Internships and other opportunities
- Student and Department complete application and submit to Advisor/DSO
- Advisor/DSO process SEVIS authorization
- I-20 with CPT confirms authorization for employer
- Cumulative duration <365 days allows OPT

Optional Practical Training (OPT)

- Employment must be related to program
- Valid F-1 status for one full academic year
- Result = 12 months US work authorization
- Requires EAD approval (60-90+ days processing)
- "Cap-gap" automatic extension after H-1B filed/accepted

Optional Practical Training (OPT)

- Pre-Completion OPT
 - Counts against post-completion OPT
 - CPT is generally better option during program
- Post-Completion OPT
 - Only 90 days unemployment permitted
 - 24-month extension for STEM degrees/E-Verify employer and training plan

Optional Practical Training (OPT)

- Student submits application to Advisor/DSO
- Advisor/DSO process SEVIS authorization
- Student sends I-765 to USCIS within 30 days
 - www.uscis.gov
 - Template letters
- Biometrics
- EAD/SS card received in mail

Optional Practical Training (OPT)

- Application window
 - Up to 90 days prior to program completion
 - Up to 60 days after program completion
 - 90 day unemployment limit
 - Minimum “employed”
 - May be unpaid
 - Minimum of 20 hours
 - International Travel
 - Need to file first
 - Need employment to return if approved
 - If resume studies, new I-20 discontinues OPT

H-1B Purpose

- To allow employers to hire foreign nationals qualified to perform "specialty occupations"
 - ITS
 - Accounting
 - Finance
 - Marketing
 - Other technical/scientific positions

H-1B Requirements

- Bachelor degree or equivalent in specialized field
- Position requires similar specialized degree
- Employer certifies to US DOL in labor condition application:
 - Job classification
 - Wage levels – Level I wage issues
 - Work location

H-1B Process – Information Gathering

- Collect Information
 - Job title, description, work location and wage from Employer
 - Credentials, immigration, biographic and family information from Employee
- Assess options
 - H-1B qualified
 - Time left on H-1B
 - In valid immigration status
 - Timing issues — CAP

H-1B Processing Timelines

- Standard Processing: 8-10 months
- Premium Processing: 15 days if available
- H-1B portability
 - If in valid H status when petition filed
 - May begin work with USCIS receipt notice
 - Do not need to wait for approval notice

H-1B Duration

- 3 year initial term and extension
- 6 year maximum EXCEPT
 - If filed permanent residence before 6th year
 - 1 year extensions beyond 6 years available if labor certification application filed
 - 3 year extensions beyond 6 years available if immigrant visa approved

TN Purpose

- To allow employers to employ Canadian/Mexican professionals in specific categories including:
 - Faculty
 - Computer Systems Analysts
 - Engineers
 - Accountants
 - Management Consultants
 - Scientific Technologists
 - Nurses — visa screen requirements

TN Requirements

- Canadian or Mexican citizenship
- Bachelor degree in field related to category
 - Accountant
 - Graphic Designer
 - Nurse
 - Occupational Therapist
 - Medical Lab Technologist
- Employment Offer

TN Requirements – Bachelor Exceptions

- Management Consultant
 - Degree or 5 years' experience
- Scientific Technologist
 - 2 year scientific degree or training
 - Work in support of degreed scientists/engineers
- Computer Systems Analyst
 - Bachelor degree
 - Post-secondary diploma/certificate plus 3 years' experience

TN Process – Information Gathering

- Collect Information
 - Job title, description, work location, and wage from Employer
 - Credentials, immigration, biographic and family information from Employee
- Assess options
 - TN category available
 - Process at border, consulate or service center

TN Processing Timelines

- Border Processing
 - Canadians only: Immediate
- Consulate Processing
 - Mexicans only : 2 weeks
- USCIS Standard Processing
 - Approx 3 months
- USCIS Premium Processing
 - 15 days

TN Duration

- 3 year initial term and extensions
 - Mexican visa currently limited to 1 year duration
 - 3 year PED so need to pay attention to I-94 expiration date
- May extend indefinitely
 - If maintain ties to Canada/Mexico
 - Often move to H-1B to facilitate permanent residence for long-term employees

International Travel Issues

- Visa processing
 - Complete at US Consulate outside US
 - Online visa application preparation
 - Documents related to visa category
 - Travel to/re-enter from Canada/Mexico for trips less than 30 days with:
 - USCIS approval notice
 - Valid passport
 - Expired visa

Employment Based Permanent Residence

- Three steps
 - Labor certification application
 - Immigrant visa
 - Adjustment of status

Labor Certification Application

- Strategic step
- Recruitment
- Generally "no American worker minimally qualified"
- Processed with Department of Labor
- Current processing approx 5 months

Immigrant Visa

- Confirm Employee meets requirements
- Confirm Employer ability to pay
- Confirms preference category

Adjustment of Status

- Dependent on available visa number
 - EB-1 Worldwide
 - EB-2 India/China nationals
 - EB-3 India/China/Philippines
- Review immigration/criminal history
- Travel restrictions if not in H or L visa status or want advance parole
- Interview now required
- Results in permanent residence

US Citizen Spouse Permanent Residence

- One step filing - Magic
 - Interview to confirm validity of marriage
 - Employment/travel authorization issued in about 90 days
 - Processed within approximately 6 months
 - If within first 2 years of marriage when approved → 2 year conditional permanent residence and need to file petition to remove conditions
 - US Citizenship application may be filed with 3 years permanent residence

Trump Administration Impact

- New DACA ended – renewals permitted
- Rumored changes to H-1B program
 - Increased wages
 - Recruitment requirements
 - Dependent employers
- Rumored changes to permanent residence
 - Update recruitment requirements
 - Increase wages
- Increased deportation
