





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ST. VINCENT PALLOTTI (1795 to 1850) was born in Rome and founded the society of the Catholic Apostolate (The Pallottines) over 150 years ago. In St. Vincent's time there was a tremendous desire for positive action. Many men and women were drawn to St. Vincent's spirit and spread his message all over the continent. St. Vincent Pallotti's dream was to enable people to assume their proper role in the mission of church and to establish a community to translate his vision into reality. He believed that all are called to revive faith, rekindle charity and be apostles. St. Vincent Pallotti was actively involved in the education of children and young people. He founded night schools in the city of Rome. He was beatified in 1950 and canonized in 1963 during Second Vatican Council. St. Vincent Pallotti lived and worked by the motto "The love of Christ urges us on". We too are guided by this motto in various apostolate. His commitment to his apostolate led him to start orphanages, night school and technical institutions that exist even today. Besides, he had special compassion for prisoners, soldiers and the sick. He was also the spiritual director of several roman colleges.



The society founded by St. Vincent Pallotti has numerous institutions in 52 countries across the globe. In India, the Pallottines have premier educational institutes of higher learning in Maharashtra, Goa, Chhattisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Delhi, Jharkhand, Bihar, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka and Kerala.

The Nagpur Pallottine Society which manages St. Vincent Pallotti College of Engineering & Technology, Nagpur is a part of the global Pallottine entity and is a Non-Profit Organization established in 2003 at Nagpur. Candidate should be an Indian National and should have passed the HSC (Std.XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination with subjects English, Physics, Mathematics and Chemistry / Biotechnology / Biology / Technical Vocational subject

AND

Secured minimum 50 % marks (minimum 45 % marks, in case of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only) in the subjects Physics, Mathematics and Chemistry / Biotechnology / Biology / Technical Vocational subject added together.

AND

Obtained a non zero score in JEE / MHT - CET

For Admission to B.E. Direct Second Year

The Candidate must be an Indian National and should have passed Post-SSC

OR Post-HSC Diploma Course in Engineering /Technology with at least 45 % marks (40 % marks in case of candidates of backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging only to Maharashtra State) in appropriate branch of Engineering / Technology from an AICTE approved Institution with English as the medium of instruction at Diploma level.

OR The Candidate must be an Indian National and should have passed B.Sc. Degree from a UGC / Association of Indian Universities recognized University with at least 45% marks (40 % marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging only to Maharashtra State) and passed XII standard examination with Mathematics as the subject and with English as the medium of instruction at B.Sc. level.

For Admission to M.Tech

Candidate should be an Indian National and should have passed Bachelor degree or equivalent in the relevant field of Engineering / Technology from State Governments / MHRD approved institutions, with at least 50 % Aggregate marks (at least 45% marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories and persons with disability belonging to Maharashtra State only) from an AICTE approved institution. The candidate should have a non-zero GATE score.




Industry Institute Interaction Cell
