

10 Week Old Fetus

On January 22, 1973, the US Supreme Court voted in favor of legalizing abortion on demand in all 50 states. The decision was based on the premise that a fetus is not person.

Since then, the intentional termination of approximately 50 million fetuses (have taken place in clinics around America – the <u>vast majority</u> of these were <u>not</u> to save the life of the mother or because of rape. The primary reason has been the personal inconvenience of the mother and/ or the father.

This past year, the Governor of New York signed a bill legalizing the termination of a born fetus.



It is the hope of hundreds of thousands of prolife people demonstrating in walks in Washington DC, Los Angeles, Chicago and other cities in America this week that the Supreme Court decision in Roe v.
