LETTER FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parish Family,

I would like to wish all the Moms a very happy Mother’s Day! You are a great blessing for your families and for the Church as well. Pope St. John Paul II said the following:

“Motherhood involves a special communion with the mystery of life, as it develops in the mother’s womb. The mother is filled with wonder at this mystery of life, and ‘understands’ with unique intuition what is happening inside her. In the light of the ‘beginning’, the mother accepts and loves as a person the child she is carrying in her womb. This unique contact with the new human being developing within her gives rise to an attitude towards human beings – not only towards her own child, but every human being – which profoundly marks the woman’s personality.”

“Motherhood implies from the beginning a special openness to the new person: and this is precisely the woman’s ‘part’. In this openness, in conceiving and giving birth to a child, the woman ‘discovers herself through a sincere gift of self’.”

“Human parenthood is something shared by both the man and the woman. Even if the woman, out of love for her husband, says: ‘I have given you a child’, her words also mean: ‘This is our child’. Although both of them together are parents of their child, the woman’s motherhood constitutes a special ‘part’ in this shared parenthood, and the most demanding part. Parenthood – even though it belongs to both – is realized much more fully in the woman, especially in the prenatal period. It is the woman who ‘pays’ directly for this shared generation, which literally absorbs the energies of her body and soul. It is therefore necessary that the man be fully aware that in their shared program of parenthood he owes a special debt to the woman.”

PARISH & COMMUNITY NEWS

FATHER MICHAEL WITTMAN OZANAM CENTER

Service to the needy at the Father Michael Wittman Ozanam Center is one of the many ministries of the Church of Saint Mary, Chardon, and one in which our parish has been actively involved for many years. In fact, this spring marks the Center's fifteenth year of operation. The Center opened in 2006, just after Easter, on the former campus of Christ the King Parish in East Cleveland (since closed). It was named for two individuals. The first person is Father Michael Wittman, who served as the pastor of Christ the King Parish at that time and who granted permission for the use of the facilities of the parish. Fr. Wittman passed away just as the Center was about to be opened. The second is Frederick Ozanam, the individual who, two centuries ago, founded the Saint Vincent de Paul Society. The Center is an outreach of the Society and the more than dozen parishes that support it. Our parish was one of the founding parishes and has served as a major contributor in terms of management, volunteers, and monetary assistance throughout its existence.

One Saturday of each month, a team of volunteers from our parish journeys to East Cleveland and the campus of Saint Philomena Church (its "new" location and part of the Communion of Saints Parish) to help with the distribution of food (including fresh produce) and clothing, as well as other programs. While the COVID-19 pandemic has forced a number of changes to the distribution process and the services provided, the ministry has continued to operate throughout. By being open, the Center has aided those who were unable to take advantage of the drive-through food giveaways offered by other organizations. Perhaps half of the people using the Center walk or take public transportation to visit the site.

The primary mission of the Center is to distribute food to the poor from this city and the surrounding zip codes. The majority of the food is obtained through the Greater Cleveland Food Bank, both at deeply discounted prices and, in some cases, for free. Produce constitutes a significant piece of the food pantry's offerings, as well as bakery goods donated by local businesses.

The Center also makes available large quantities of clothing for those in need. All clothes are obtained through donations made by individuals, organizations, parishes, and occasionally retailers. Due to the pandemic, the distribution of clothing has been severely limited, primarily to cold weather wear, and further altered with the use of volunteer "personal shoppers" to select clothing for the needy. As the negative impact of the pandemic is reduced, it is anticipated that an incremental expansion of the clothing distribution program (to its prior standards) will take place, including making available spring, summer and fall apparel along with bedding and towels, so long as a supply of these items exists. Many parishioners have participated in this ministry over the years, some for a short time period and others for years. There are no specific requirements associated with volunteering other than to be available for service one or more times per year. Families are strongly encouraged to participate, with the parents/guardians responsible for their charges; the children should be of sufficient age to actually perform work and understand the mission. It is an opportunity for the more fortunate to better understand and respond to those who are disadvantaged. Organized groups have also volunteered.

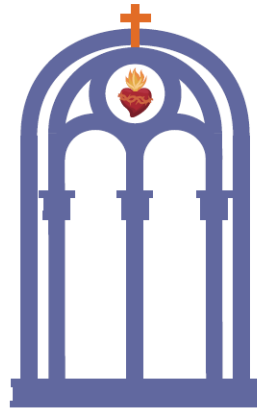

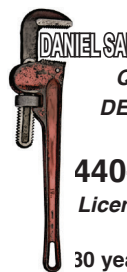

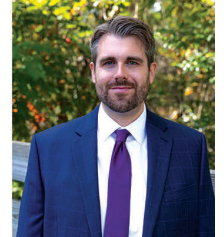
