Features	Definitions
Difficulty of Customization	The level of difficulty companies will have tailoring this software to fit their company.
Bank Reconciliation	This feature helps deter check fraud, reconciles multiple bank accounts, analyzes estimated cashflow, and controls who can access and adjust balance entries. This module is restricted to those with necessary access to this information.
Cost Accounting & Analysis	These allow you to set up a detailed cost structure for every operation and product to include purchased materials and components. You can apply the cost structure to inventory at any time to obtain valuation based on a choice of cost models.
Multi-Company Financial Consolidation	This allows you to group multiple companies to view a consolidated profit and loss statement, balance sheet, and trial balance.
Multi-Currency Transaction Management	This feature tracks and analyzes transaction activity in multiple currencies. Allows you to perform currency conversions, create a range of exchange rates, record gains and losses due to fluctuations in exchange rates, and set up unlimited numbers of exchange schedules.
Project Accounting	This allows project managers to track actual against estimated costs through forecast completion which helps prevent cost overruns and generates bottom line savings.
Project Costing	This allows you to manage jobs on different levels to include the contract, project, and category so you can specify the cost account to be used in cost transactions for each job category.
Project Expense Tracking	This allows you to track purchases and expenses against projects.
Revenue Recognition	This feature helps automate revenue recognition processes and support the latest compliance rules such as regulations on multi-element sales.
Investment Accounting	This is a feature that can help track and optimize investments made within the company.
Materials Management	This feature is also known as inventory management by many vendors and helps you track inventory and materials in the warehouse.
