CRASHING THE GLASS

Delaware leads the country in offensive rebounding, grabbing 20.4 offensive boards per game. At 4.9 offensive rebounds per game, Ty Battle ranks 6th in Division I in the category individually, while Jasmine Dickey is 8th with 4.8.

The Blue Hens also rank 5th in Division I with 47.2 total rebounds per game, while Battle is the CAA's top rebounder with a clip of 11.2 boards per game.

BLUE HENS REWRITE RECORD BOOK IN 2020-21

The Blue Hens also recorded top-15 point totals in school history in wins against St. John's (93-88) and James Madison (94-88, OT). Delaware also tied for the second-most team rebounds in program history with 63 boards in a win against Towson on Feb. 27.

Blue Hens Leading The Way For Change

In the wake of the killing of George Floyd that sparked worldwide outrage and protests, Delaware women's basketball head coach Natasha Adair knew she needed to bring her team, a diverse group of young women, together.

Over a Zoom meeting, she posed two questions. The first: how are you feeling?

Confused. Sad. Hurt. Angry.

The second: what do you need from us as coaches and what do you need from each other?

"Support" was a common refrain, but one answer stood out from the others – direction.

In a historic moment of social activism, the members of Delaware women's basketball did not want to sit idly by; they wanted to be a part of a positive change to make their community a better place to live.

Inspired by some of her friends outside the team, Paris McBride offered the idea to write a letter to mayors across the state of Delaware calling for reforms. The Blue Hens crafted a document that, among other things, called for more thorough psychological examinations when hiring police officers, a ban on chokeholds and the type of restraint that killed Floyd, and funding for bodycams for officers.

Adair passed the letter on to Director of Intercollegiate Athletics and Recreation Services Chrissi Rawak, who tasked Gino Gradkowski, the Assistant Director for Student Services Leadership, with making sure the letter got in front of UD's government and community relations team. Those connections led to a meeting on June 24, where the women's basketball team was joined by athletes from football, volleyball and swimming & diving at a face-to-face meeting with the Attorney General of Delaware, Kathy Jennings. John Carney, the Governor of Delaware, also spoke to the group via Zoom.

The next day, Carney signed Executive Order #41, which bans the use of chokeholds by State of Delaware law enforcement agencies, increases community engagement, requires additional de-escalation and implicit bias training, and increases the availability of crisis intervention services for law enforcement officers. The Delaware General Assembly passed a bill banning chokeholds on the same day.

- Redshirt junior Ty Battle has been named to the newly formed NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Student-Athlete Engagement Group, which will serve as an amplifying voice for women's basketball on key initiatives, legislation, and various issues.

- Head coach Natasha Adair, along with Delaware football offensive lineman James Prince III, has been named to the CAA Family - United For Change Executive Committee, a newly-formed 14-member group tasked with addressing the critical issues of racial and social injustice.

Natasha Adair was selected as just the fourth women's basketball head coach in the program's illustrious history on May 14, 2017.

In her fourth year at the helm, Adair was named the 2020-21 Colonial Athletic Association Coach of the Year. After being picked to finish sixth in the preseason poll, the Blue Hens completed their best campaign since 2012-13, capturing the CAA Regular Season Championship and sweeping seven of its nine conference series.

In her first season with the Blue Hens, Adair guided Delaware to its most wins (19) and first postseason appearance since the 2013-14 campaign. Additionally, the Hens captured 10 conference victories for the first time since 2012-13.

Under Adair, the Blue Hens were an offensive threat as Delaware averaged its most points (65.8) since 2012-13. Additionally, the Hens logged 80-plus points in six different contests for the first time in six seasons while logging five straight games of 70-plus points to open the year while UD only reached 70-plus points three times in each of the previous two seasons.

Delaware also saw the fifth player in program history pick up Conference Player of the Year accolades as forward Nicole Enabosi earned the Colonial Athletic Association's top individual award while also garnering CAA All-First Team and All-Defensive Team honors for the second straight season.

Adair, who has more than 20 years of coaching experience under her belt, has received the national attention of USA Basketball and has served as an assistant coach for the U19 and U18 Women's National Basketball Teams and has spoken at the USA Basketball Las Vegas Coach Academy. Additionally, Adair served as a U19 Women's World Cup Team Trials Court Coach during the summer of 2017.

Adair joined the Blue Hens from Georgetown University, where she turned around a four-win Hoya program to a postseason contender in three seasons as head coach. Behind Adair's leadership, GU finished 2016-17 with a 17-13 record, the most wins for the Hoyas since 2011-12, and garnered the team's second straight trip to the Postseason WNIT.

The Silver Spring, Md. native is no stranger to the Colonial Athletic Association as her first head coaching stint took her to the College of Charleston, where she was 35-31 overall. In the Cougars' first season in the CAA in 2013-14, Adair guided The College to record of 19-15, marking the third-highest win total in the school's Division I era.

Adair played collegiately at Pensacola Junior College (1990-92) before playing and graduating from the University of South Florida with a degree in communications in 1994. She previously spent 13 seasons in the assistant coaching ranks, with seven years (2004-12) at Wake Forest University and six seasons (1998-04) at Georgetown University. Her coaching career has seen her develop and mentor 12 players who went on to play at the professional level.
