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PREFACE

The practice of emergency medicine is a complex mission. Successful practice includes emergency stabilization, patient assessment, diagnostic tests, and medical interventions. The Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education and the American Board of Emergency Medicine have established the Emergency Medicine Milestone Project, a framework for assessment of residents in training in twenty-three milestones, from Emergency Stabilization to Teamwork.

Each chapter addresses an important ethical topic in emergency medicine, including issues, controversies, and a summary of Ethics Takeout Tips. Available online are educational modules for use in teaching ethical principles at any level. It is our hope that this book will serve as a valuable resource to emergency providers and educators.

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
