

Background information

November 14th 2017 a call for proposals: ISFP-2017-AG-FORENSIC

This call for proposals aimed at funding projects in the area of forensic science in the EU with a specific focus to stimulate the exchange of forensic data via Prüm and to improve its quality





The prediction of future behaviour?

- Number of image capturing devices grows rapidly (Wireless infrastructures for CCTV and Surveillance systems, in-car video systems and body cameras)
- Quality of video/images improves constantly
- A broad availability of facial images (EU- or national databases, device biometric locks, social media etc.)
- Automatic facial recognition technology





Project specific objectives


- 1) What are the current practices and procedures across EU Member States regarding the use of facial data for crime investigations?

- 7) What is current and long-term vision within different European countries regarding the future of pan-EU exchange of facial data?
- 8) What steps can be taken for the further harmonisation of this area across Europe?
