# About Oslo

Oslo, Norway is one of the most prominent places among Norway and the capital city of Norway. It is Norway's largest town with a population of 647,676 individuals in 2015. In 2016, the land GDP of Oslo, Norway enhanced by solely 0.8 proportion point, that is weakest growth since the monetary crisis in 2009. Client value inflation in 2015 was 1.1 per cent. However, seasonally adjusted quarterly figures show that land GDP growth through 2016 was somewhat stronger than through 2015, when there was no growth within the fourth quarter of 2016, land GDP enhanced by 1.3 per cent, whereas trend growth is calculable to be regarding 2 percent expectations of a moderate improvement through 2016.
