Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or have AKC Limited Registration, or are of a breed that have obtained an AKC PAL/ILP/ Canine Partner/Foreign# Dogs eligible for entry in the Miscellaneous Class at dog shows are eligible to participate.

Spayed bitches and neutered males are eligible to participate. Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, dogs that are blind or suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance, are not eligible.

Move Up Regulations

If a dog earns an agility title before this event, it can be advanced to the next level of competition. However, written notice MUST be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 6pm on Monday

08/13/18 Move ups will be accommodated from Friday to Saturday and Saturday to Sunday at the trial. No verbal changes will be accepted.

<u>MOVĚ UPS</u>

Day-to-Day move ups must be turned in to the trial secretary no later then 1/2 hour after judging has finished. Dogs so moved up will be entered at the end of the running order. No changes accepted from the "A" division to the "B" division of the Novice class during the Trial

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running or risk losing a Qualify score.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required to submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. At the handler's option, dogs may be entered in a higher jump height class. After the close of entries, jump height changes to a lower division are **NOT** allowed.
