# **Catalog of Free Educational Technology Tools**

#### **Audio:**

<u>Audacity (Links to an external site.)</u> Audacity is free, open source, cross-platform software for recording and editing sounds. Audacity is available for Windows, Mac, GNU/Linux and other operating systems.

<u>Free Natural Reader (Links to an external site.)</u> It can convert any written text such as Microsoft Word, webpages, PDF files, and E-mails into spoken words.

<u>imTranslator</u> (<u>Links to an external site.</u>) offers a natural sounding text-to-speech system with translation capabilities that quickly translates text and reads it aloud at one click of a button.

#### Video:

Animoto (Links to an external site.) Unlimited Videos for Educators. Enhance your digital classroom with Animoto, an ideal tool for creating videos and presentations. It takes just minutes to create a video which can bring your lessons to life. Educators can apply for a free Animoto Plus account for use in the classroom. Its powerful features can be used to create stunning presentations incorporating images, video clips, music and text.

Ezvid (Links to an external site.) Ezvid is a 100% free video creation tool that allows you to capture everything that appears on your computer screen. It also allows you to edit your recorded videos by splitting your recordings, inserting text and audio, controlling the speed and even drawing directly on your screen.

<u>GoAnimate (Links to an external site.)</u> Make Amazing Animated Videos! Use the Video Maker to create videos for free.

<u>Voki (Links to an external site.)</u> Voki is a FREE service that lets you create customized avatars, add voice to your Voki avatars, post your Voki to any blog, website, or profile, and take advantage of Voki's learning resources.

#### **Presentations:**

<u>Slideshare (Links to an external site.)</u> With SlideShare, you can gussy up your plain PowerPoint with an embedded YouTube video or audio file to make it a more media-rich experience for viewers. And once it's done, you can embed or share it widely and share automatically to your LinkedIn account.

Google Presentations (Links to an external site.) Part of Google Drive, this tool gives you the ability to mimic PowerPoint, but it has the advantage of being online. You can import an existing PowerPoint presentation for editing, or start from scratch with Google's own templates. And there are 450+ fonts you can use too. You can embed images and YouTube videos, but unfortunately not sound, which may limit its utility for some users. Once your presentation is done, you can publish to the web, embed or share. The killer feature: multiple people can work on a presentation at once.

<u>Prezi</u> (<u>Links to an external site.</u>) is one of the most exciting presentation tools in this roundup. Although you can import PowerPoint, the best way to experience it is to create a Prezi from scratch. You start with a canvas, some transformation tools and some whizzy templates with exciting transitions. Group ideas in frames and add symbols, shapes and diagrams.

<u>Haiku Deck</u> (<u>Links to an external site.</u>)Create visually stunning presentations that allow you to tell a story and share via Facebook, Twitter, or email and view them on any web-enabled device.

<u>Google Chart Tools (Links to an external site.)</u> Provides several tools for making data more comprehensible. Special URLs can be used to embed graph and chart images in users' own web.

<u>infogr.am (Links to an external site.)</u> Create infographics and interactive online charts. It's free and super-easy! Follow other users and discover amazing data stories!

<u>JeopardyLabs (Links to an external site.)</u> allows you to create a customized jeopardy template without PowerPoint. The games you make can be played online from anywhere in the world. Building your own jeopardy template is a piece of cake.

<u>Padlet (Links to an external site.)</u> Padlet is a free application to create an online bulletin board that you can use to display information for any topic. You can add images, links, videos and more!
