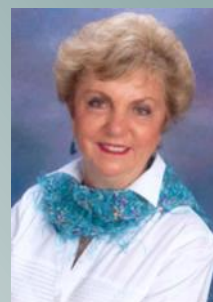
It was truly a lovely evening with delicious foods, great danceable music, and beautifully –clad people all making it a President's Ball to be remembered.

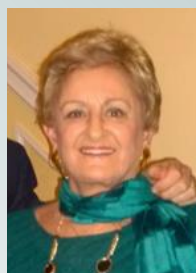

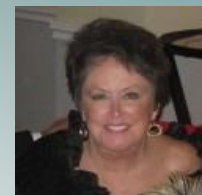
ALMONER'S REPORT
