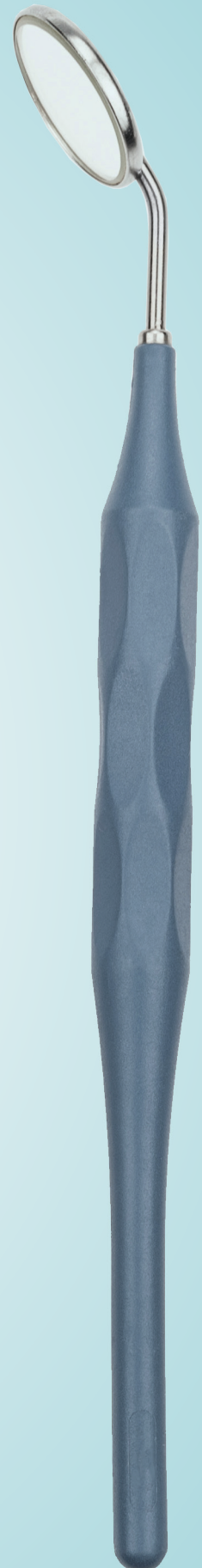

Professor Avijit Banerjee

Avijit is Professor of Cariology & Operative Dentistry / Hon. Consultant and Clinical Lead, Restorative Dentistry at the Faculty of Dentistry, Oral & Craniofacial Sciences, King's College London / Guy's & St. Thomas' Hospitals Foundation Trust, London, UK. He holds the positions of Head of Conservative & MI Dentistry, Director of Education (UG) and Programme Director of the innovative KCL distance-learning Masters in Advanced Minimum Intervention Dentistry. He also leads the Cariology & Operative Dentistry research programme at the world-leading Faculty (as part of the Centre of Oral & Clinical Translational Science), researching, publishing and lecturing internationally about MI operative caries management, adhesive dental biomaterials and clinical. He acts as an international R&D KOL for many international Industry partners, including GCE / UK, 3M Oral Healthcare, Septodont, Dentsply Sirona, Colgate and P&G Oral B. Avijit is primary author of Pickard's Guide to Minimally Invasive Operative Dentistry amongst other book editorships. He is editor-in-chief of Oral Health & Preventive Dentistry (Quintessence Ltd) and an editorial board member of Dental Update, British Dental Journal, International Journal of Adhesion & Adhesives and the Primary Dental Journal. He is a member of the British Dental Association Health & Science Committee also, all whilst maintaining wet-fingered specialist clinical practice in Restorative Dentistry, Prosthodontics & Periodontics. He is the immediate past-President of the BDA Metropolitan Branch London Section (2019-20) and holds an Hon. Consultant Advisor position to the Office of the Chief Dental Officer, England.

Dr. Marielle Blake

He is a Diplomate of the American Boards in both specialties. After over 40 years in practice, he now serves as Co-Clinic Director for Graduate Orthodontics at UBC Vancouver. He has lectured world-wide, and published extensively.

Dr. Patricia O'Connor

Dr. Patricia O'Connor is a Consultant Physician in Internal Medicine and Clinical Senior Lecturer in Clinical Pharmacology and Therapeutics in St James Hospital and Trinity College Dublin. Her areas of special interest is Cardiovascular disease prevention with a particular interest in management of Lipid disorders and Hypertension.

Dr. Peter Cowan

Dr. Peter Cowan qualified in dentistry from Trinity College Dublin in 1978. He was a part-time lecturer/clinical tutor in the Dublin Dental School in Oral Surgery and Restorative Dentistry 1981-91. Professor Juan Yepes

Juan F. is a full professor in the Department of Pediatric Dentistry at Indiana University School of Dentistry and an attending at Riley Children Hospital in Indianapolis, Indiana. Juan F. is also an adjunct professor at the University of Buffalo School of Dental Medicine, Department of Pediatric and Community Dentistry. Juan F. is a dentist (DDS) and a physician (MD) from Xavier University at Bogotá, Colombia. In 1999, Juan F. moved to the United States of America, and attended the University of Iowa and the University of Pennsylvania where he completed a fellowship and residency in Radiology and Oral Medicine respectively in 2002 and 2004. In 2006, Juan F. completed a Master in Public Health (MPH), and in 2011 a Doctoral Degree in Public Health (DrPH) both with emphasis in Epidemiology at the University of Kentucky College of Public Health. In 2008, Juan F. completed a residency program in Dental Public Health at Texas A&M University College of Dentistry. Finally, Juan F. completed a residency program and a master in pediatric dentistry at the University of Kentucky in 2012. Juan F. is triple board by the American Boards of Pediatric Dentistry, Oral Medicine, and Dental Public Health. He is an active member of the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry, American Academy of Oral Medicine, American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology, Indiana Dental Association, and American Dental Association. He was also Training program Director for Oral Surgery for Northern Ireland.

Dr Paul Quinlan

Dr. Quinlan graduated from the Dublin Dental School 1991. He completed an M.Sc. in periodontology at the Eastman Dental School, London, in 1993. In 1996 he was awarded a fellowship in Dental Surgery from the RCS Glasgow and he also received a Fulbright Scholarship for study in the USA. Dr. Ed Madeley qualified with First Class Honours from Cardiff University in his native Wales. Following graduation Dr Madeley worked in a mixed NHS and Private practice in South Wales, before relocating to Dublin in 2010. Dr. Hani Nazzal

Dr. Hani completed three years clinical training in Paediatric Dentistry at the University of Leeds in 2008 after which he obtained a Fellowship in Paediatric Dentistry from the Royal College of Dentists in Canada in the same year. He then worked as a Senior Dental Officer in Paediatric Dentistry at Bradford and Airedale Salaried Dental Services between 2008 and 2012. He became a member and then a fellow of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow (Paediatric Dentistry) in 2015 and 2016. He worked as an academic Paediatric Dentist consultant at University of Leeds in 2017. In 2018, Dr Hani was appointed as a senior consultant in Paediatric Dentistry at Hamad Medical Corporation. Academically, he obtained a PhD in paediatric Dentistry from the University of Leeds, School of Dentistry in 2008. In 2012, he was appointed as a NIHR Clinical Lecturer in the paediatric dentistry Department where he was involved in undergraduate and postgraduate education. Dr Hani is also the founding president of the Arabian Academy of Paediatric Dentistry. His research interests are in the field of fluoride anticariogenic effect; slow releasing fluoride device, dental plaque, regenerative endodontics and the use of laser Doppler flowmetry. Hani has multiple publications and co-authored several book chapters in addition to presenting in several UK national and international conferences. In addition, Dr Hani is currently an associate editor of the Paediatric Dentistry and Orthodontic sections of Dental Traumatology Journal.

Dr. Frank Gallagher

Dr. Gallagher qualified from Dublin Dental Hospital in 1991. He worked in General Dental Practice in the UK from 1992 to 1996 and completed Masters in Endodontics at the Eastman Dental Institute in London in 1997. Dr. John Lordan

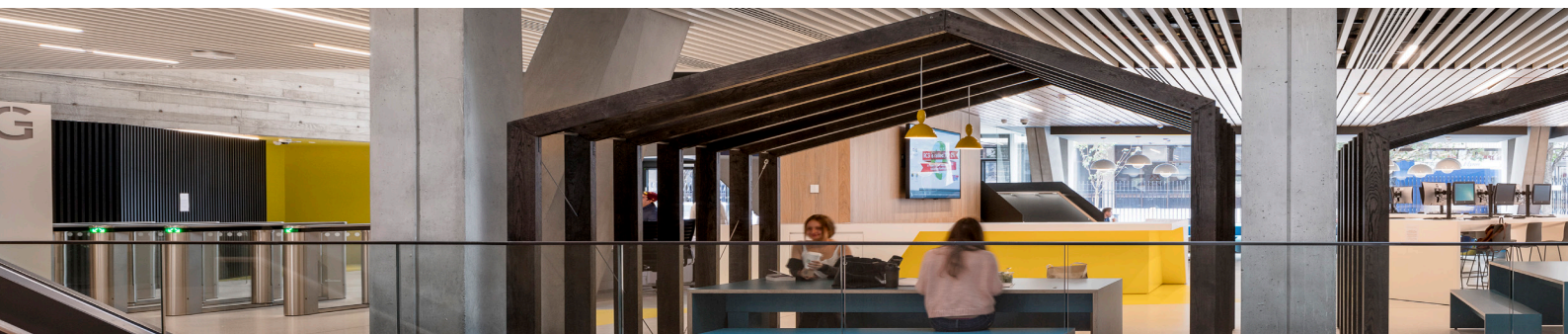

The techniques he acquired during this time are considered the gold standard in endodontic therapy and Dr Lordan applies this expertise daily in his practice at the Northbrook Clinic with excellent treatment outcomes. Dr. Lordan is a regular presenter and attendee at endodontic meetings at home and abroad and utilizes state of the art technologies to achieve the desired results in an efficient and pain free environment.

Dr. Rory Boyd

Prof. Stanley Melamed

Stanley F. Malamed is a dentist anesthesiologist and emeritus professor of dentistry at the Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry, located in Los Angeles, California, USA. Prof. Malamed graduated from the New York University College of Dentistry in 1969 and then completed a residency in anesthesiology at Montefiore Hospital and Medical Center in the Bronx, New York before serving for 2 years as a captain in the U.S. Army Dental Corps at Ft. Knox, Kentucky. In 1973, he joined the faculty of the University of Southern California School of Dentistry (now the Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry of U.S.C.). Prof. Malamed retired from full-time teaching at the university in 2013. Prof. Malamed is a Diplomate of the American Dental Board of Anesthesiology; a recipient of the Heidebrink Award [1996] from the American Dental Society of Anesthesiology; the Horace Wells Award from the International Federation of Dental Anesthesia Societies, 1997 (IFDAS), and the Leonard M. Monheim Distinguished Service Award from the American Society of Dentist Anesthesiologists (2015). Prof. Malamed has authored more than 170 scientific papers and 17 chapters in various medical and dental journals and textbooks in the areas of physical evaluation, emergency medicine, local anesthesia, sedation and general anesthesia.

Dr. Norman Tinanoff

Dr. Tinanoff has authored or co-authored over 200 publications, primarily on fluoride mechanisms, antimicrobials, caries risk factors, early childhood caries and prevention. His current interests are concerned with preventing dental caries, oral health access for underserved child populations, and developing clinical policies and guidelines for the ADA, AAPD and the IAPD.

Dr. Kathy Harley

Dr. Harley graduated from Guy's in 1981 and completed a Masters degree in Conservative Dentistry at the Eastman Dental Institute in 1986. She was appointed Consultant and Honorary Senior Lecturer in Paediatric Dentistry at the Eastman in 1991. Following a move North in 1999 Dr. Harley took up the position of Consultant in Paediatric Dentistry at the Edinburgh Dental Institute where she was also Head of Department until 2011 when she became Dean of the Faculty of Dental Surgery at the Royal College of Surgeons of England. Dr. Harley returned to work in London in 2015 taking up a part-time consultant post at the Eastman Dental Hospital and that year also joined a private practice to gain experience of working as a Specialist in a practice setting. Subsequently she moved to join the Paediatric Dental team at Great Ormond Street Hospital in March 2018 where she works 2 days per week and continues to enjoy her day in practice.

Professor Declan Cody

Prof. Declan Cody is a Consultant in Paediatric Endocrinology and Diabetes in Beacon Hospital and in Our Lady's Children's Hospital Crumlin. Declan graduated from UCC and completed his paediatric training in Ireland and subsequently in Alder Hey Children's Hospital in Liverpool. He was appointed as a Paediatric Endocrinology consultant in University Hospitals Leicester in 2002 before being appointed as Consultant in Paediatric Endocrinology and Diabetes in Our Lady's Children's Hospital in 2006. Declan was a National Specialty Director of the Paediatric Specialist training programme from 2008-2014 and is the current RCPI Paediatric lead for the International Fellowship programme in Paediatrics. He was appointed as UCD Clinical Professor in 2018.

Dr. Kate Coyle

Dr. Coyle qualified from Queen's University Belfast (QUB) with Honours in 2002. She undertook specialist training in Paediatric Dentistry in Belfast, Dublin and Manchester. Presently works as consultant and clinical lead in Paediatric Dentistry within the Royal Belfast Hospital for Sick Children. She is responsible for undergraduate Paediatric Dentistry teaching for QUB and is clinical director of dentistry in the Belfast Health and Social Care Trust.

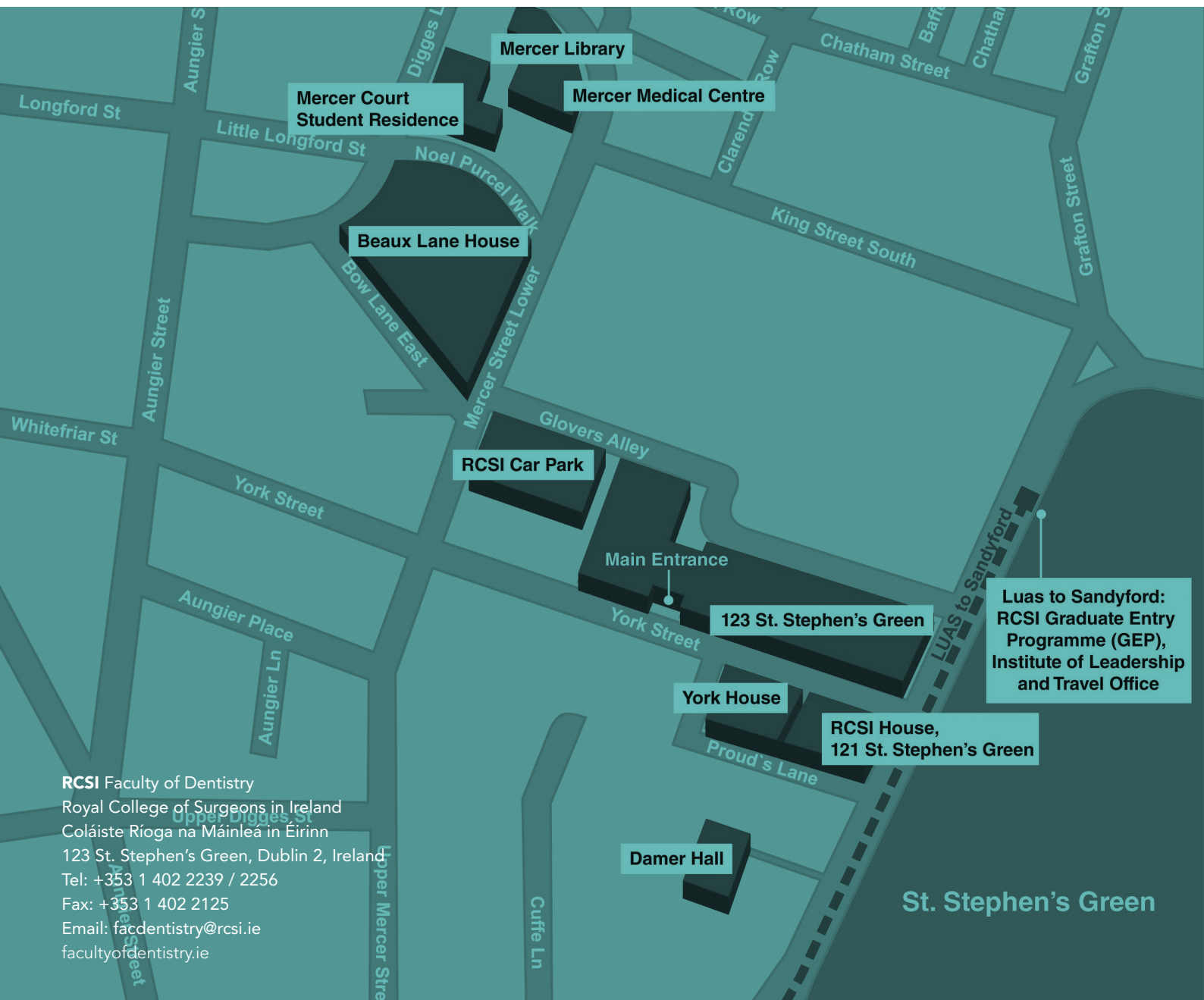
