

From Father Andrew Infanger, Associate Pastor



Hello! My name is Fr. Andrew Infanger, and by now I may have met many of you at the parish, but you will have to apologize if I forget your name. If you see me around, please remind me! This is my first assignment as a priest - I was ordained on May 19 of this year. Our gospel readings

for this Sunday hopefully can be the 'mission statement' of my ministry here at the parish. God does not rejoice in the death of the living, but seeks us out, to heal us and bring us to eternal life. It is a task that I need to do in my own life, and one that you are sure to help me with along the way. In fact, it is the mission of the whole Church. If we ever fail to proclaim the good news of salvation in Jesus Christ, then we fail to be a Church. In my short time here, I know that it is a challenge both to live in my own life, and to profess toward others, and I'm sure it is the same with you.

It's rather easy to forget all this though. Life is busy, and seems to keep getting busier. I now have more email addresses and text messages and calendar invites than I have ever had in my life, and it only gets worse. Life gets ahead of us and before you know it, we go from swimming to treading and then to sinking, and we forget why we are doing all of this, and where we are heading. It happens in our personal life (at least mine), in our families, and even in our parish. Why come on Sunday? Why give to the life of the parish? Why are we taking time to pray on our own, to bring our kids to faith formation? Are they just one more thing shouting for attention in the midst of 10,000 things which seems vitally important?

Proverbs 28:19 says, "people without a vision perish." Without the end sight in mind, we'll drown. Today calls us back to our visionl, and shows us how to reach it. It's like a fresh drink of water on a hot summer day, or seeing the sign that says "West Bend" on the highway after a long road trip. We are headed to eternal life, which isn't a given for any of us. It doesn't require strength, or another email address or a new cell phone to achieve. It requires the humility of the woman in our Gospel, to simply reach out and touch God. It's what we do every Sunday in the Eucharist, in each confession, in each act of mercy and every prayer. I hope I can help you along that way at the parish to eternal life, and I ask you do the same for me. We can't do this alone.




