- 2. accessed your BUE email address and logged onto the SRS
- 3. met your Personal Tutor
- 4. completed a Library Induction
- 5. printed a copy of your weekly programme timetable and know when your first class is in Teaching Week 1

How to access your BUE email address

- 1. Your BUE password and username will be sent to your registered personal email. You can also collect your BUE password from Student Affairs.
- 2. Your email address is username@bue.edu.eg, where 'username' is your *First Name* followed by your *BUE ID number*.

For example if your first name is Ahmed and your BUE ID number is 110200 then your BUE email address will be Ahmed110200@bue.edu.eg

- 3. From any internet browser go to http://mail.bue.edu.eg
- 4. Web mail will open and request your email address and password.
- 5. Enter your full BUE email address and the given password.
- 6. Set your local time zone.
- 7. The given password can be changed from:
 - a. https://pwd.bue.edu.eg
 - b. The BUE eLearning site
