Our multi-platform awareness campaign starts each year in April, officially proclaimed "Safe Digging Month" by the Governors in Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island and Vermont.

The longtime landscape expert from the hit shows This Old House and Ask This Old House, Roger has a huge following with yard improvement enthusiasts. 

## **Call Center News**





In July, Dig Safe partnered with Paradigm Liaison Services to create a custom One Call Center video to be viewed by excavators throughout our five New England state region.

Paradigm specializes in the implementation of public awareness programs (API RP 1162) for the oil and gas pipeline industry. They travel across the country providing safety classes for first responders. When they hold classes in our area, the five minute video will be shown to give a snapshot of the one-call laws in Massachusetts, Maine, New Hampshire, Rhode Island and Vermont.

The production was shot and edited by Corey Tyrell and Robert Soto of Paradigm, and features Dig Safe Executive Director Bob Finelli, Call Center Manager Amy Worden, and Public Relations Director Lisa Powers.

To our loyal Dig Safe supporters,

At the end of each year when the excavation season winds down to a close, Dig Safe sends out a letter to New England excavators to recap milestones from the past year. In 2015, we have broken records for the highest number of tickets in a day (4,410 on May 11) a week (18,387 from May 4-8) and before the end of the year, it looks like we will surpass our annual ticket count from last year.

This tells us that our economy is recovering, construction is on the upswing, and more of you are calling in for every single job, even the smaller projects that you may have not have notified us for in the past. In our media advertising, and on the phones, our message has consistently been to call us for everything, and our consistently rising numbers are evidence of that happening.

Also in our annual letter, we send out a survey to find out how we can better service you as the callbefore-you-dig center in Massachusetts, Maine, New Hampshire, Rhode Island and Vermont. Thank you for your opinions! Be assured that we tabulate all responses, and read each and every comment. We certainly learn a lot from you!

Here's some great news about the two most common recommendations that we get from our frequent users who responded to our survey:

We have recently upgraded our online mapping system by adding a Google Map layer to our existing map databases. This means that more and more of the streets you describe are available on our system.

I'm also happy to announce that the mobile app you've been asking for is ready. Since it's launch in 2014, we've enjoyed a steady increase in users who apply for tickets on smartphones and tablets. The technology was in development for over a year, and was worked and refined until we were completely satisfied with the finished product. Feedback has been overwhelmingly positive. Contractors are enjoying its ease of use, the convenience of applying for tickets in the field, and the feature that allows them to email tickets to themselves for easy record keeping.
