





My house was on the very edge of the evacuation zone for the River Fire. It made the national news and was just a few miles from here. It burned along a river that we kayak on and know very well. The town of Colfax was evacuated, which is where we turn off Highway 80 to come to our house, not many miles as the crow flies. We were out of town (see below) so it was all beyond our control!

Our hobby has such a rich history. No matter how deeply we each explore it, there always seems to be things we've missed or couldn't afford or just have never seen


Yet there's always new things I haven't seen before, and that is the treasure hunt aspect of collecting that I do love
