#### BASIC CLOSURES

Sew-on snaps and hooks & eyes are the most frequently used closures for fastening and finishing garments. Traditionally, fasteners have been hidden. Today fashion uses them on the outside, as key elements of the design.

# Hooks & Eyes hold finished edges together.

#### **Traditional**

• Hooks with round or straight eyes. Use round eyes where two edges meet and straight where two edges overlap.



#### Specialty

• Wide and Sturdy. Use on lapped waistbands of skirts and pants.



# Coat

• Large size for use on coats and jackets



#### Covered

• Thread-covered for fur and deep-pile fabrics.



#### Jumbo

• For bulkier fabrics, fleece and wool.



• Makes a custom bow tie out of your choice of fabric.



# Sew-On Snaps hold overlapping edges together.

#### Traditional

• Guide holes ensure alignment.

# Nylon

• Clear snaps blend with fabric color.

# Snap Tape

• For children's clothing, shirt closures, pillow and duvet covers.



# **Magnetic Snaps**

• Use to secure opening on purses, bags or totes.





#### **4-PART SNAP FASTENERS**

Several styles, applied with special tools or pliers and contain 4 parts.

#### **Snap Fasteners**

• Open-ring metal snaps for children's wear.



#### **Pearl Snap Fasteners**

• Metal snaps with decorative pearls for blouses, shirts and western wear.



### **Heavy Duty Snap Fasteners**

• Decorative metal snaps with long prongs for heavy and bulky fabrics.



#### **Color Snaps**

• Plastic snaps with metal prongs for children's wear, blouses and shirts.



# **Heavy Duty Snaps**

• Strong metal snaps for jackets, coats, ski wear and boat covers.



#### Mini Anorak Snaps

• Brushed-finish metal snaps for dresses, vests, jackets and coats.

#### **EYELETS & GROMMETS**

The terms eyelet and grommet are used interchangeably. Eyelets and grommets are round metal 1- or 2-piece reinforcements for holes in fabric, plastic and paper. They can be either functional or decorative.

• Use small eyelets for belts, drawstrings, laced closures, tote bags and decorative

• Use large eyelets and grommets for window treatments, shower curtains, duffel bags and tarps.

The size indicates the inside diameter of the opening of the eyelet or grommet.

#### SCREW TOGETHER GROMMETS

Heavy duty metal two-part grommets fit together and are secured by small screws. The grommets add a professional finish and decorative accent to clothing, belts, bags, totes, and purses.

Available in 15 mm, 35 mm and 45 mm sizes.

#### LOCKS

Decorative and functional metal hardware often found on bags, purses, wristlets, backpacks, belts, etc.

#### Turn Lock

Locking closure to keep openings closed and secure.





#### Press Lock

• Push-in closure designed to secure flaps and straps.





# Flip Lock

• Flip-down locking latch closure to keep openings closed and secure.



#### **HOOKS & FOBS**

#### Swivel Hooks

- Attach to D-Rings to create detachable straps or internal hooks on bags and totes.
- Use with parachute cord to create key chains, bracelets and other craft projects.



#### Carabiner

- Metal loop with spring action opening.
- Use to clip two objects together.

# **Key Fob Hardware Set**

- Design and make your own key fob or lanyard.
- Use with belting, fabric, elastic, ribbon or a combination of materials.



#### **BUTTONS**

Cover Buttons are used to make half hall fabric-covered shank buttons.

# Aluminum: 1/2" to 1½" Diameter

- Smooth underside with shank attached to button. hack
- Tools are required for covering.



- Shank is attached to button cover for added strength.
- Teeth on underside of button grip fabric so tools are not required.

#### Jeans and Dungarees Buttons

- No-sew closures for jeans, side openings of overalls and sportswear.
- The design on jeans buttons coordinates with the buckle buttons for overall side closures.



#### BUCKLES

#### **Overall Buckles**

- Buckles with no-sew jeans buttons for overalls and jumpers.
- Hammer required for button application.



#### **Vest Buckles**

• For fitting and cinching back ties on vests.

#### Slide Buckle Set

- Adjustable metal buckle used with belting, elastic or fabric.
- Includes two belt tips.



• Plastic buckles for belts, luggage, sporting equipment and tote bags.





#### **RINGS & ADJUSTERS**

## **Plastic Rings**

- Most commonly used for home decor.
- Use 1/2" for the back of Roman, Austrian and balloon shades.
- Use larger sizes for cafe curtains and tiebacks.
- Available 1/2" to 1½".

#### **D-Rings**

- Make adjustable ties, belts, straps and purses.
- Use as decorative accents on pillows and home décor projects.
- Available 3/4" to 2".



#### **Slide Adjusters**

- Use to make strap lengths adjustable for a perfect, comfortable fit.
- For straps on bags, tote, purses, suspenders and pet collars.



#### **TAB CLOSURES**

- Accent skirts, garments or other accessories.
- Pre-stitched faux leather.



# **TOGGLES**

- Wood buttons and faux leather tabs with pre-punched stitching holes.
- Use on coats, sweaters, bags/totes and other decorative projects.



#### **GARMENT FINISHING**

#### **Rivets**

• Small metal accents reinforce pocket corners on jeans, overalls and jackets.



#### **Belt Tips**

• Metal tips encase raw edges of webbing, strapping, ribbon and fabric for a finished appearance.



# **Cord Stops**

 Use on drawstrings in waistlines, pants hems, jackets and bags to prevent cord ends from slipping into casings.



# Suspender Slides

- Use to adjust length of straps for a perfect fit.
- Slides keep suspender straps in place and secure.



# Mitten Clips

• For making suspender, mitten and pacifier clips.
