Dear friends,

Hope you are doing well and trying to stay warm during this winter and experiencing the warm love of Jesus.

During my visit home to India, I had my annual medical checkup with my family doctor. He discovered a serious medical condition which will require immediate and ongoing treatment.

After consulting with Bishop Ricken, I will be returning to India at the end of this month to receive this treatment. Sadly, I do not expect to return to the Green Bay Diocese. The Diocese offered to help me receive medical attention here in this country, but I prefer to go back home to receive treatment.

I wish for this serious medical condition to remain personal. It is not related to any behavior on my part, nor is my return to India connected to any issue other than my health. Before this health issue came up, I had even discussed staying permanently in the Green Bay Diocese, and I loved my first year here in Appleton especially at St. Bernard Parish working the vision for this wonderful Parish.

The Diocese is working to provide a short and long term replacement.

Please keep me in your prayers and you will be in mine. Thanks for your overwhelming support and prayers for me at St. Bernard Parish.


