TECHNICAL CORNER

Last month, Craig Froet of Froet Industries, told us about the changes happening in the industry concerning roof drains. Did you know that roof drains have never

been defined by water flow rate? The same roof drain has different flow rates depending on the depth of water at the roof drain. The average depth of water for sizing a roof drain is 5/8". ASPE/IAPMO have standards for flow test criteria, and are having these standards as part of the code so all manufacturers will be required to submit standardized testing results. IPC 2015 requires roof drain flow testing.

Most roof drain have a strainer to catch debris from entering the drain and a large percentage always need cleaning. This condition is compounded by when a screen is use, such as for green roofs. Therefore, never install a screen on a strainer and regularly clean the roof drain strainer. For a green roof, make sure to install a screen away from the roof drain, so the drain will receive only rainfall and not debris.

Craig is working with the standards committee to have other criteria required by the standards so engineers will have more information to base a roof drain selection. A future need of the standards is the requirement for a pressure sensor in the test pipe. The sensor will help unify the test results across manufactures.





As you may have heard in last month's newsletter, the City of Philadelphia has reestablished the Plumbing Advisory Board. Their first and primary task is to update the Philadelphia Plumbing Code. One debate that the Board is facing is whether to update the existing code or adopt the 2018 International Plumbing Code with amendments.

The Philadelphia Code as it stands has been a successful code for many decades and periodic updates and bulletins have al-

lowed for the code to evolve over the years. Unfortunately, the Plumbing Code evolution in Philadelphia has been slower and more often disputed in comparison to the state adopted International Plumbing Code.

No one seems to debate the fact that the Philadelphia code is outdated and needs a rewrite. Technologies have evolved quite a bit over the years and the Philadelphia Code has not necessarily caught up. Some newer technologies present an economic advantage for projects and while others have been developed as a result in need for increased public safety. The timetable has been set to modernize.

Hopefully with the reincarnation of the PAB, and once the new Code is established, there will be a new footprint to allow for future code updates on a more frequent basis.

As this is an exciting opportunity for Philadelphia to re-establish themselves as a progressive city. Our Chapter has volunteered our services to form a committee and provide unbiased technical opinions should we be called upon to do so.

LEED Platinum-Certified Apartment Building Uses Submetering to Dramatically Reduce Water Consumption

PROJECT BACKGROUND

A 32-story, new construction, 500-unit apartment building known as 360 State Street in New Haven, Connecticut, wanted to install an innovative submetering system to track the residents' water & hot-water heating data while providing tenants with an easy-to-use web portal to access and manage their utility data.



H2O Degree delivered a submetering system consisting of a 1,000 dual point-of-entry water meters (hot & cold) and 591 thermostats. The battery-powered wireless water meters communicate with the thermostats. The thermostats act as transceivers, a unique feature of H2O Degree's wireless



network, which results in substantial savings compared to using traditional wireless repeater networks. When considering the minimal wiring it took to set up the radios and ZigBee mesh network the system uses, the system was the most cost effective option for the building.

PLUMBING CONFIGURATION

The dual point-of-entry submetering at 360 State Street means that the plumbing is configured so that one riser branches into the apartment for cold water. A second


