# 30 insane facts about dogs

### Dogs and humans

- 1 A dog's nose is like a human fingerprint, in that it can be used to identify them.
- The maximum sentence in South Carolina, USA for beating your dog is longer than the sentence for beating your wife!
- 3 Dogs only have 1,700 tastebuds compared to humans who have 9,000.
- 4 Paul McCartney added in an extra high-pitched whistle in the song 'A Day in the Life' for his Shetland sheepdog.
- 5 Lord Byron was so outraged that Cambridge Trinity College wouldn't let him bring his dog so he brought a bear instead.

## **H**istory

- 12 Spiked dog collars origniate from Ancient Greece where they were designed to protect their dog's throats from wolf attacks.
- 13 Dogs curl up when they're sleeping because of an old-age instinct, so that they can protect their vital organs when asleep.
- 14 The earliest fossils of dogs date back to 10,000 B.C.
- 15 All dog breeds are descended from a species called the Tormarctus, a hyena-like creature that lived over 15 million years ago.
- 16 The famous mythical guardian of the Underworld in Greek mythology was the three-headed dog Cerberus.

#### Different breeds

- 21 There are two dogs who have black tongues: The Chow Chow and the Sharpei.
- 22 Greyhounds can run up to 45 miles per hour, making them the fastest dogs on the earth
- 23 The Newfoundland dog breed was originally bred to help fishermen, and so have a water resistant coat and webbed feet.
- 24 The Norweigian Lundehund is the only dog breed to have six toes on each foot.
- 25 Bloodhounds have the ability to trace scents that are over 300 hours old.
- 26 The Basenji, an African wolf dog, is the only breed of dog that cannot bark.



#### Characteristics

- The only sweat glands that dogs have are between their paw pads.
- 7 A dog's sense of smell is more than 100,000 times stronger than a human's.
- 8 Dogs can see in the dark due to a special membrane in their eyes called the tapetum lucidum.
- 9 Dogs have wet noses because they lick their noses and absorb scent chemicals, so that they can smell better.
- 10 It has been proven that dogs can actually 'smell' some types of cancer.
- 11 Dogs release oxytocin (the love hormone) in their brains when they interact with dogs and humans.

#### **Statistics**

- 17 It is estimated that in the US, 1 million dogs have been named as the primary beneficieries of their owners' will.
- 18 The oldest dog to date lived to be 29 years and 5 months old.
- 19 In America, more than 1 in 3 families have a dog.
- 20 In 2002 more people were killed by dogs than sharks in the US.

#### Cases of real-life dogs

- 27 With help from the ASPCA, some of Michael Vick's fighting dogs have now become certified therapy dogs.
- There's a Border Collie called Chaser who can recognise 1,022 words.
- The first big Hollywood dogs star was Rin Tin Tin, after he was rescued during the First World War.
- Fido, Abraham Lincoln's dog, was also assassinated.

# Timber Ridge Dog Training Club Awards Policy

### 1. Purpose

- A. To encourage Timber Ridge Club members to participate in shows, trials and other events with their dogs, and to promote the sport of dog training and showing.
- B. To recognize the achievements of Timber Ridge Club members and their dogs.

## 2. Eligibility

- A. Each recipient must be a member as of **March 1**, of the year in which the award is given.
- B. Either one of the following 2 requirements must be met.

Members must attend 1 meeting per year & make a significant contribution to the club. The contribution may include Chairing a trial, serving as Awards Chair, Newsletter Editor, Coordinating Fun Day. The position must not receive compensation in any other form.

Member must work at 3 club events (e.g. help with classes, seminar, set or give a program, help plan or work at a fun match, trial, mall demo, etc)

Members must attend 3 meetings

Member must work at 3 club events (e.g. help with classes, seminar, set or give a program, help plan or work at a fun match, trial, mall demo, etc)

C. Each applicant must notify the awards chairman of accomplishments in writing by the date set by the Board and published by the Club in its newsletter. Proof of titles, dates and locations of club events at which qualifying scores were received, and of club events where the applicant worked, shall be provided to the awards chairman. A record of attendance at meetings shall be provided by the club secretary.

#### 3. Awards

A. Awards will be provided for the following titles:

Champion (breed), DC, CD, CDX, UD, UDX awarded by the AKC, UKC & Canadian Kennel Clubs.

In agility, all titles awarded by AKC, UKC, USDAA and NADAC shall be rewarded.

In tracking, all titles by the above organizations for TD, TDX, VST & tracking champion.

In field, all titles awarded by such as JH, SH, MH, NA, UT, VC & FC

In herding, PT, HS, HI, HX, & herding champion HC.

In flyball, FD, FDX, FDCh, FDCh.-S, FDCh-G, FM, FMX, FMCh.

In obedience/rally all titles awarded by ~ AKC, UKC

In Barn Hunt all titles awarded by such as ~ RATN, RATO, RATM

In Coursing Ability Trial awards, such as ~ (CA) Coursing Ability, (CAX) Coursing Ability Excellent

B. The Timber Ridge Club will provide an award engraved with the dog's registered name or call name, for the above-mentioned titles. The amount of the cost will be approved by the Board.

(At this time, the Board has approved the awarding of a wooden plaque, with space at top for a photograph and space at the bottom for an engraved metal plate for each award. The Club will pay for half of the cost of the plaque (\$26.45), and half of the cost of one plate (\$4.75). The recipient is asked to pay for any engraved plates for awards earned before this year, or for more than one plate for this year's awards, if separation of awards is desired.

- C. Dogs ranking #1 for the year by a national association will receive a special award.
- D. Awards larger than the above (B) will be provided for an OTCH (obedience trial champ.), MACH (master agility champ.) Grand Champion, ONYX, HOBBES, U-ATCH (UKC agility trial champ.), FC or title of equal standing. Club will pay half of the cost of the award up to \$30.00 ????
- E. CGC awards will be recognized with a certificate of accomplishment at time of receipt.
- F. Additional awards may be recognized each year at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

To be eligible for an award, you must fill out the application on the reverse of this policy in full, and mail it, with copies of title certificates.




