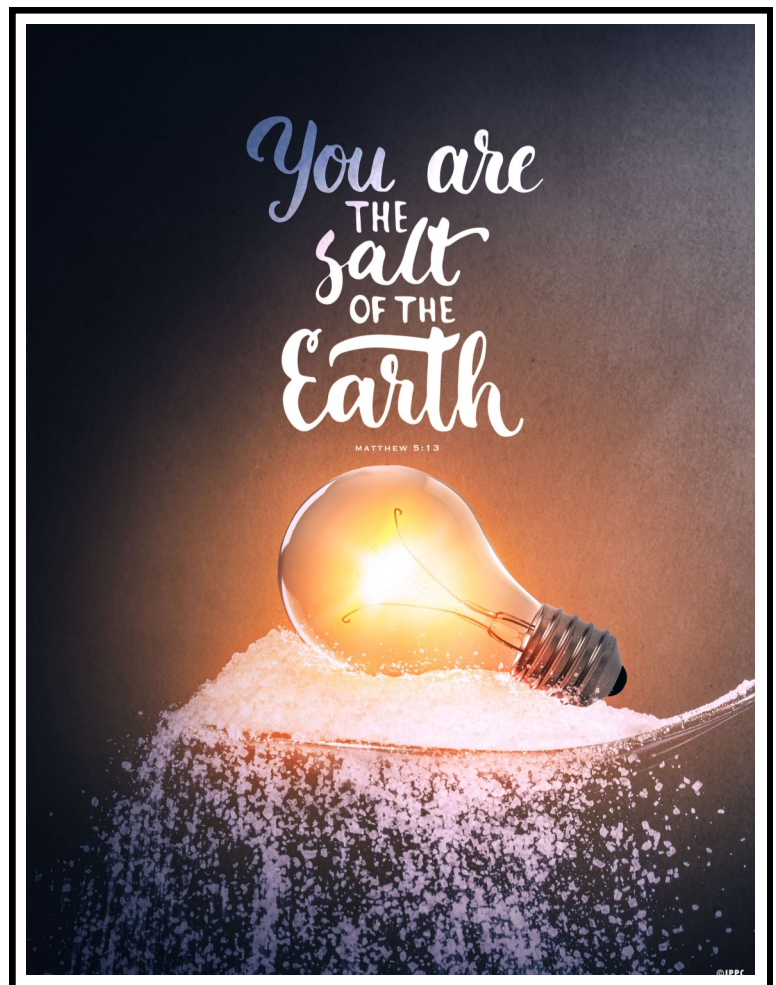



From the Archives

From *The Inquirer*, Lancaster, Pennsylvania, Saturday, April 9, 1910:

“There was a great surprise in Catholic circles when the inventory on the estate of Rev. Dr. P. J. McCullough, for 35 years rector of St. Mary’s Church, this city, was filed. It was supposed he left only a few thousand dollars, but the inventory showed an estate of \$184,600 in gilt-edge securities. Under his will \$1000 is for masses for himself, \$1000 for masses for all members of St. Mary’s Church who died within 50 years, and \$1000 to the poor of St. Mary’s. The balance of the estate is to be divided equally between the Little Sisters of the Poor of Philadelphia and his relatives. The Philadelphia charity will get about \$85,000.”
