


Figure 91 Melbourne Museum, Milarri Garden and the forest gallery beyond. Source: Reproduced from *Architecture Australia*.




Figure 93 Melbourne Museum, approach from Nicholson Street. Source: Reproduced from *Architecture Australia*.




Figure 91 Melbourne Museum, Milarri Garden and the forest gallery beyond. Source: Reproduced from *Architecture Australia*.




Figure 93 Melbourne Museum, approach from Nicholson Street. Source: Reproduced from *Architecture Australia*.
