Through interactive presentations, industry professionals help students become more financially literate. Available to teachers grades 6-12, the program offers a variety of topics that provide real-life lessons in money management.



PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- More than 90 volunteers delivered presentations to 2,000+ students at Patrick Henry and Robbinsdale Cooper High Schools.
- Volunteers from six organizations impacted 2,400 eighth graders at the Minneapolis STEM Expo. Organizations represented included FamilyMeans, Financial Planning Association of MN, Minnesota Bankers Association, United Educators Credit Union, Wells Fargo, and Wings Financial Credit Union.





them in classrooms.


This past year, committees created presentation materials for a new presentation on Paying for College, updated Credit Matters, and hosted two volunteer engagement events.
