THE FINGER LAKES

Tips and knowledge before you go

Did you know:

- The Finger Lakes region consists of 11 long and narrow lakes in upstate New York & covers about 9,000 square miles
- Seneca, Cayuga and Keuka lakes are the largest of the lakes
- Skaneateles Lake has some of the cleanest fresh water in the world and is the only lake not connected to the Erie canal system
- The region boasts an abundance of breweries, wineries, museums, hiking trails and farm to table eateries



There are about 146 wineries in the entire region

Four organized wine trails:

- Canadaigua Lake; 12 wineries
- Keuka Lake; 22 wineries
- Seneca Lake: 67 wineries
- Cayuga Lake; 32+ wineries

Dr. Konstantin Frank winery (Keuka lake) is credited with planting the regions first successful vinifera ("wine bearer") vines transforming the region to international status

Cayuga Wine trail is "America's first wine trail" established in the early 1980s.

Watkins Glen International (Seneca lake) hosts the annual Finger Lakes Wine Festival every summer

The region produces over 200 different Riesling brands

The wine trail is opened year around with many restaurants (seasonal) and lodging options sprinkled in along the path
