#### **2014 Synod and Presbytery Report** Bonclarken Assembly, June 10-12, 2014

Barry, Philip, Bob Robinson, John Barron & Max Smith represented our church at the Presbytery and Synod Meetings held at Bonclarken. Some highlights include:

#### Summer Meeting of Catawba Presbytery - Barry Dagenhart, Moderator

- Retiring ministers include Boyce Wilson (Ebenezer ARP) and Tony Grant (York ARP). Tony (father of member Martin Grant) has been diagnosed with cancer and is under Hospice care. Philip Bunch will be the interim moderator of the York ARP Session.
- Chaplain Peter Johnson (LTC, US Army) transferred into the Presbytery. He begins a one year deployment to Kuwait in July.
- Agreed to provide Presbytery financial support to member Zach Simmons, serving at RiverCrossing Church.

#### Meeting of General Synod – Larry Littlejohn (Mississippi), Moderator

- Philip Bunch led Synod's worship service on Wednesday morning.
- The new Form of Government has been approved and is now in effect. (The Session will be considering the effect of changes and will let the congregation know of changes as they are refined.)
- Drafting of a new Book of Discipline is still in progress.
- The ARP Church added two chapters to the Westminster Confession of Faith in 1959. Synod sent to the presbyteries a proposal to remove them.
- Confirmed the denomination's 1977 stance on homosexuality. Due to conflicting state laws, it did not take a new specific stance on same-sex marriage. A pamphlet on The Gospel and Sexual Orientation was endorsed.
- Alex Pettett was introduced as the new Executive Director of World Witness. Alex and Jamie Pettett have served as missionaries in Israel and Turkey. Frank van Dalen is returning to missions in Lithuania.
- The Pacific Presbytery (made up predominately of Korean congregations) has been dissolved. Individuals interested in continuing with the ARP denomination were asked to join another presbytery.
- Expanded boundaries of First Presbytery to include the Chicago area.
- Elected Rev. Jamie Hunt (Coddle Creek ARP, Mooresville, NC) as the Moderator-elect. He will assume the position of Moderator at next year's meeting of General Synod.

F irst ARP has been tremendously blessed this past year through the All American Athletes program (our sports outreach to children with special needs). It has given us the opportunity to minister with and alongside families who have children with developmental delays as well as their siblings. Several of these children recently attended VBS and it is evident the Holy Spirit is working in their lives.

This Spring, several families have inquired as to whether or not our church could incorporate their children – those with developmental delays as well as their brothers and sisters—into our Sunday School classes and church life. Both the Just Joy and Christian Education committees believe God is calling us to step out in faith and minister to these families in more personal ways.

We have previously partnered with Joni and Friends, who recommends an <u>inclusion based buddy system</u>. Essentially, each child who has a developmental delay is partnered with a buddy and placed in already existing classrooms. With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we are preparing to phase this system into place beginning on Rally Day.

A Buddy Training Session will be held on Saturday, July 26<sup>th</sup>. If you interested in being trained and serving as a buddy, please



contact Jamey Dagenhart. If you are interested in serving in this ministry, but cannot attend the session on July 26, a later session will be scheduled.
