A Word from the Pastor

One of the most respected research groups related to churches in the United States is the Barna Group. They have been interviewing, surveying and researching a host of issues related to US Christianity for decades.



Barna began a new State Of The Church project in January last year. Some of their findings were rather interesting. Here are two:

- 1. One in three practicing Christians has stopped attending church, either in person or online, during COVID-19.
 - One commentator stated that it was as if these people were simply taking COVID-19 off, kind of like vacation. Online attendance has fallen, too.
- 2. White Christians have become even less motivated to address racial injustice after the surge of protests last year.

It sounds like the violence and destruction associated with these protests negatively affected people who otherwise might have been more open to addressing such issues.

My college Statistics Professor used to say. "The numbers are a snapshot of a particular moment in time. They may or may not represent the overall truth about something." So, how do we interpret these findings?

Judging from other sources I have read and conversations with a variety of people near and far, my sense is that both are relatively accurate. Are they a continuation of a trend? Perhaps. Will the numbers be same following the end of the pandemic? We don't know.

I've heard many people talk about 2020 and say something like, "Good riddance! I'm glad that year is over." Given the situation, that's understandable.

On the other hand. I hope we have learned a few things in 2020. We are still alive. So are others. So is God! Hmmm, I wonder what a Christian life will be like after the pandemic, including at FLC?


