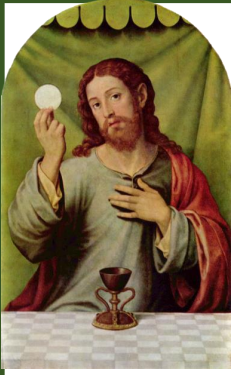

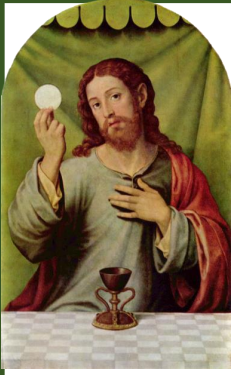

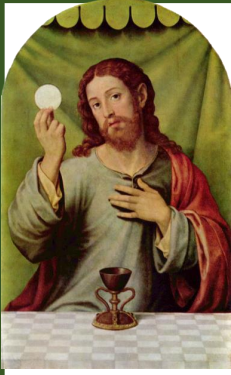

of all things visible and invisible.

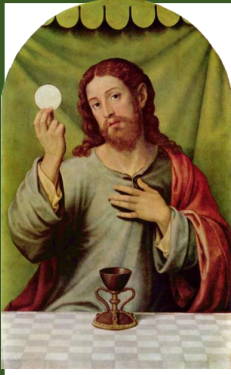
I believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ,

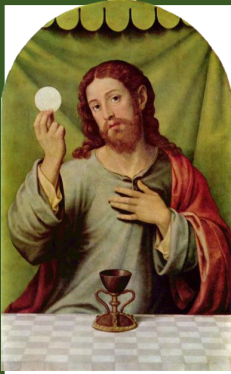

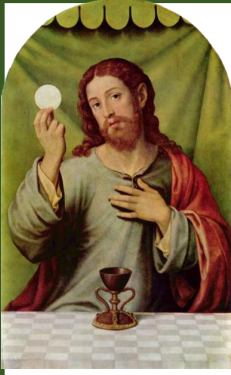
