The Good News As Seen Through a Window



Recipe Corner

Black-Bottom Cupcakes

(from: Jane Foster)

Ingredients:

1½ c. all-purpose flour 1 tsp. baking soda

½ tsp salt

1 c. sugar

½ c. cocoa

1 c. water

¹/₃ c. vegetable oil

1 Tbsp. white vinegar

1 Tbsp. vanilla extract

1 (8 oz.) pkg. cream cheese, softened

1 large egg

½ c. sugar

1 (6 oz.) pkg. semi-sweet chocolate mini-morsels

Instructions:

Combine first 5 ingredients in a large bowl; make a well in center of mixture.

Combine water, oil, vinegar, and vanilla; add to dry ingredients, stirring well.

Spoon batter into paper-lined muffin pans, filling two-thirds full.

Combine cream cheese and next 2 ingredients, stirring well. Stir in chocolate morsels. Spoon cream cheese mixture evenly over chocolate batter in each muffin cup..

Bake at 350⁰ for 10-15 minutes. Immediately **remove** from pans. Yield: 5 dozen.

"<u>When Lightning Struck</u>" by Danica Cooley is a novel based on the life of Martin Luther. This book, donated by Ruth Ann Hoehn, is written for teens. However both Ruth Ann and I found it great read - both educational and inspirational.

"<u>Once Upon a Town</u>" by Bob Greene is not a new book, but new to our shelves. It is the true story of a little town in Nebraska. During World War II troop trains passed through North Platte, Nebraska and made a brief stopover. The people there turned their small depot into a canteen and offered food, gifts and support to the servicemen. They continued this from Christmas 1941 'til the end of the war. It is a great story of American patriotism.

Brad Hewitt and James Moline have co-authored the book "<u>Your New Money Mindset</u>". They offer ideas on how to create a healthy relationship with money, These two Christian authors explain how we can live in a consumer-driven society, be wise with our money and live generously.

Finally, if you like historical novels, you may enjoy "*The Stamp of Glory*" by Tim Stafford. This is the story of a family in he early 18-00's that loses their plantation when the father dies. In his will, he frees all his slaves. The book follows the lives of his four children as well as one of the freed slaves. This is really a good read, full of historical background from 1824 - 1863.

Ruth Ann's Ramblings ... (contributed by Ruth Ann Hoehn)

While looking for something to write about this month, I came across the story about the song "I Know Who Holds Tomorrow." I first heard that song a few years ago when Virgil sang it, and it has become a favorite of mine.

Ira Forest Stanphill (February 14, 1914 – December 30, 1993) was born in Bellview, New Mexico to Andrew and Maggie Stanphill. He spent most of his younger years in Coffeyville, Kansas.

By the age of 10, Stanphill had already become a fluent musician, having learned to play the piano, organ, ukulele, and accordion. He went on to learn to play xylophone, guitar, saxophone, and clarinet. By the age of 17 he was composing and performing his own music for church services, revival campaigns, and prayer meetings. During his life Stanphill composed more than 500 songs.

He graduated from the Junior College in Chillicothe, Missouri, and began preaching when he was 22. He was later awarded an honorary Ph.D. from Hyles-Anderson College in Indiana. He traveled the United States and Canada and to 40 countries to preach and perform his music. He was in-duct-ed in-to the Gos-pel Mu-sic Hall of Fame in 1981, and the Southern Gospel Music Association Hall of Fame in 2001. He pub-lished his au-to-bi-o-graphy, *This Side of Heav-en*, in 1983.

He was a pastor at churches in Oklahoma, California, and Pennsylvania. He was music director at churches in Texas. In 1956, he was the founding pastor of Bethel Assembly of God Church in Lake Worth, Florida.

In the 1970s, Stanphill's ministry included a 30-minute weekly television program, *Young At Heart* that originated in Chicago. In the 1990s, he appeared with his second wife Gloria on several Southern gospel music videos produced by Bill Gaither.

In 1939 Stanphill married Zelma Lawson. Stanphill and Zelma had a son, Ray. That marriage ended in divorce in 1948. She died in a car accident in 1951. Following Zelma's death, he married his second wife, Gloria Holloway. They had two daughters, Judy and Cathy.

In 1976, Stanphill was diagnosed with a malignant tumor. He underwent successful surgery and lived 17 more years. Stanphill died of a heart attack December 30, 1993, in Overland Park, Kansas, He was buried in Johnson County Memorial Gardens, Johnson County, Kansas.

In the 1940's, after his divorce, Stanphill reached a personal low in his life. Some criticized him for continuing to preach after his divorce. He pondered the direction of his future. One day he poured out his feelings to God and began humming a tune. He didn't know where the tune had come from, but when he got to the church that day, he rushed to a piano and started writing "I Know Who Holds Tomorrow." The words and melody flowed out of him, and he felt at peace. The experience didn't give him all the answers he wanted, but it gave him the total trust in God he needed.

"There are things about tomorrow That I don't seem to understand; But I know who holds tomorrow And I know He holds my hand."






Seniors are Recognized
