## **Safe Spaces Policy**

#### Introduction

The goal of the church is to provide a safe environment for all employees, members, friends, visitors, volunteers, leaders, and others while upholding Christian values and conduct. The purpose of this policy is to create a safe space and environment for children (anyone under the age of 18) and adults.

#### Standards of Conduct

The ethical conduct of all who minister at First Presbyterian is of utmost importance to the church.

- Sexual misconduct is a misuse of authority and power that is in conflict with Christian ethical principles by abusing trust relations to gain advantage over another for personal pleasure in an abusive, exploitative, and unjust manner.
- Sexual misconduct takes advantage of those vulnerable and those who are powerless to act for their own welfare, especially children (anyone under the age of 18).

#### Reporting & Responding

- Reports of allegations of sexual misconduct shall not be taken lightly. The integrity and reputation of the victim, the accused, and the church is held in the utmost care while upholding confidentiality, before and after they have been submitted to the appropriate authorities.
- All alleged abuse shall be reported and investigated.
- Mandatory reporting of child abuse has specific requirements outlined in the Book of Order.

### Responding to Allegations

- The response to allegations shall proceed according to procedures outlined in Rules of Discipline in the Book of Order.
- Allegations regarding non-members will be reported to appropriate authorities.

## Prevention and Risk Management

All persons seeking to work with children (anyone under the age of 18) must complete and sign a safe spaces policy acknowledgement form. All persons working with children include:

- Those who will be involved in the nursery, child and youth activities
- Those who will be involved in overnight activities with minors;
- Those counseling minors;
- Those involved in mentorship of minors.

Two unrelated adults shall be present at all times for any activity involving children (anyone under the age of 18).

### **Training**

Volunteers working with children (anyone under the age of 18) and youth may be asked to complete periodic training events.

#### Appendix A

#### **Definitions**

Accused is the term used to represent the person against whom a claim of sexual misconduct is made.

Accuser is a term used to represent the person claiming knowledge of sexual misconduct by a person covered by this policy. The accuser may or may not have been the victim of the alleged sexual misconduct. A person such as a family member, friend, or colleague may be the accuser.

Children is anyone under the age of 18.

*Council* is a representative body composed of ruling elders and teaching elders: sessions, presbyteries, synods, and the General Assembly. A council may have both church members and nonmembers as employees.

*Employee* is the comprehensive term used to cover individuals who are hired or called to work for the Church for salary or wages.

*Entity* is the term used to refer to any program or office managed by a board, committee, council, or other body whose membership is elected by a council.

*Inquiry* is the term used in the Rules of Discipline to determine whether charges should be filed based upon allegations of an offense received by a council. See *Book of Order*, D-10.0000.

Persons Covered by this policy includes church members, church officers, teaching elders, and nonmembers who are employees or volunteers First Presbyterian Church of Somerset, KY.

Response is the action taken by the council or entity when a report of sexual misconduct is received. It may include (1) inquiry into facts and circumstances, (2) possible disciplinary action (administrative or judicial or both), (3) pastoral care for victims and their families and others, and (4) pastoral care and rehabilitation for the accused and care for their families.

Sexual Misconduct is sexual activity or coercive sexual advances toward another person against his/her wishes. It includes behavior directed at another person's sexuality or sexual orientation with the intent of intimidating, humiliating, or embarrassing another person, or subjecting them to public discrimination. Prohibited sexual misconduct includes unsolicited and unwelcome contact that has sexual overtones.

Victim is a person claiming to have been harmed and/or abused by a person covered under this policy.

Volunteer is the term used for those who provide services for First Presbyterian Church of Somerset, KY. Volunteers include persons elected or appointed to serve on boards, committees, and other groups. For purposes of this policy, volunteers are treated the same as employees.
