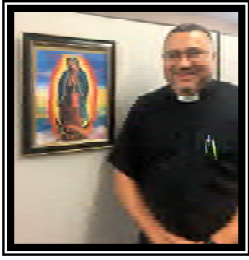

## From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today we celebrate the First Sunday of Lent, the Gospel reading in each Lectionary cycle is about Jesus' temptation in the desert. This event in the life of Jesus is reported in each of the Synoptic Gospels—Matthew, Mark, and Luke—but it is not found in John's Gospel. This year we read Mark's account of this event.

Mark tells us that the Holy Spirit “drove” or made Jesus go out into the desert. God wanted His Son to be tested. Imagine Jesus going 40 days without food, being continually tempted by Satan to use His powers as God to create food and end His hunger.

Imagine Jesus, lonely and with only wild desert animals to keep Him company, being reminded continually by Satan that He is God's Son and greater than the angels who are ministering to His frail human body to keep it alive. Why not just end all this suffering and use His powers to escape the desert and rule people now as king? Why submit to the Father's painful plan to suffer and die for sinful, ungrateful, rebellious humanity?

The fact that Jesus spent 40 days in the desert is significant. This recalls the 40 years that the Israelites wandered in the desert after being led from slavery in Egypt.

Remembering the significance of these events, we also set aside 40 days for the season of Lent. Let this Lent be an opportunity for you and me to grow in grace.

The Lessons learned into the temptation of Jesus:

First, it teaches us that Jesus overcame every temptation, so we need to follow his example and make every effort not to fall to temptation.

Secondly, Jesus did not sin; he took all the sin of humanity onto his own head, but all the sin in the world was no match for the Son of God.

Thirdly, In Christ God destroyed the work of the devil and defeated sin: our sins once and for all.

Fourthly, In Christ God has done for us what we could never do for ourselves. He has taken our sins on himself, forgiven us, reconciled us with himself and made us a new creation in Christ—redeemed, healed in mind, spirit and body and perfectly unified with Him.

In conclusion, in our own temptations we can take heart. Christ is with us drawing us to him and away from sin, but when we do sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ, the Righteous One who not only set the example for us, but also made atonement for the sins of the whole world including ours.

Jesus have Mercy on Us!

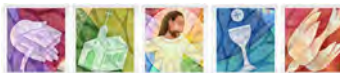

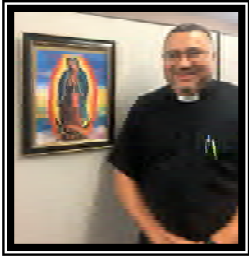

## Del Escritorio de el Pastor

Queridos hermanos,

Hoy celebramos el primer domingo de Cuaresma, la lectura del Evangelio trata sobre la tentación de Jesús en el desierto.

Marcos nos dice que el Espíritu Santo "impulsó" o hizo que Jesús saliera al desierto. Dios quería que su Hijo fuera probado. Imagínese a Jesús pasando 40 días sin comer, siendo continuamente tentado por Satanás para usar sus poderes como Dios para crear comida y acabar con su hambre. Imagínese a Jesús, solo y con solo animales salvajes del desierto para hacerle compañía, al que Satanás le recuerda continuamente que Él es el Hijo de Dios y más grande que los ángeles que ministran a Su frágil cuerpo humano para mantenerlo vivo. ¿Por qué no simplemente poner fin a todo este sufrimiento y usar Sus poderes para escapar del desierto y gobernar a la gente ahora como rey? ¿Por qué someterse al doloroso plan del Padre de sufrir y morir por la humanidad pecadora, ingrata y rebelde?

El hecho de que Jesús pasó 40 días en el desierto es significativo. Esto recuerda los 40 años que los israelitas vagaron por el desierto después de ser sacados de la esclavitud en Egipto.

Primero, nos enseña que, así como Jesús venció todas las tentaciones, debemos seguir su ejemplo y hacer todo lo posible para no caer en la tentación.

Segundo, Jesús no pecó; tomó todo el pecado de la humanidad sobre su propia cabeza. Pero todo el pecado del mundo no era rival para el Hijo de Dios.

Tercero, en Cristo, Dios destruyó la obra del diablo y derrotó al pecado: nuestro pecado de una vez por todas.

Y cuarto, en Cristo, Dios ha hecho por nosotros lo que nunca podríamos hacer por nosotros mismos. Él tomó nuestros pecados sobre sí mismo, nos perdonó, nos reconcilió consigo mismo y nos hizo una nueva creación en Cristo: redimidos, sanados en mente, espíritu y cuerpo y perfectamente unidos con él.

En conclusión, en nuestras propias tentaciones, entonces, podemos animarnos. Cristo está con nosotros, atrayéndonos a él y alejándonos del pecado, pero cuando pecamos, tenemos un abogado para con el Padre, Jesucristo, el Justo, quien no solo nos dio el ejemplo, sino que también hizo expiación por los pecados del mundo entero, incluyendo el nuestro.
