# **MAY RECIPES**

#### **Rhubarb Dream Bars**

Crust:

1 cup flour

1/2 cup sugar

1/2 cup butter

Filling:

2 large eggs

1 cup sugar

1/4 cup flour

1/4 tsp salt

2 cups diced rhubarb

Preheat oven to 350\*F. Grease (or spray) the bottom and sides of an 8x8" pan.

Whirl the three crust ingredients in a food processor and then press into the bottom of the prepared pan.

Bake for 15 minutes, crust will remain very pale in color.

While crust is baking mix together eggs, sugar, flour and salt and whisk well.

Stir in rhubarb. Pour onto crust and bake additional 40-45 minutes.

Let bars cool completely and cut into squares to serve.
