



The New Product Approval System

- This two pronged system will allow <u>manufacturers the</u> <u>choice</u> of applying with local jurisdictions for local approvals or applying with the Florida Building Commission for state approval.
- Criteria has been established for the approval of entities that test, evaluate and certify products. Quality assurance programs will be used to monitor manufacturing production of approved products.

Accreditation Bodies

Accreditation bodies accredit and monitor the competency and performance of an agency carrying

out specific tasks.

Evaluation Entities

Evaluation entities conduct product evaluations based on tests reports, and/or rational analysis.



Testing Labs

Testing labs conduct product tests.




Certification Agencies

Certification agencies evaluate products based on tests and/or rational analysis; conduct quality assurance; certify compliance with standards; and list and label products.

Quality Assurance Agencies

Quality assurance agencies monitor product production.



Validation Entities

Validation entities certify compliance with standards and certify to the Florida Building Commission that product approval applications are correct.





Local Product Approval or

"Optional"

State Product Approval



The following category of products **must be approved by local building departments** using this system or the **manufacturer has the option** of seeking state approval by the Florida Building Commission:

- Panel Walls
- **Exterior Doors**
- Roofing Products
- Skylights
- Windows
- Shutters
- Structural Components
- New and Innovative Building Envelope Products

The following products are exempt:

- 1. Structural components covered by United States Department of Commerce Product Standards;
- 2. Structural components comprised of materials or products that are assembled or placed in the field may demonstrate compliance by a batch ticket or bill of lading made available at the site of assembly or placement; and

Exempt products continued:

3. 553.842(11), Florida Statutes

Products...which are custom fabricated or assembled shall not require separate approval under this section provided the component parts have been approved...and the components meet the standards and requirements of the Florida Building Code...

VERY IMPORTANT!!

All products in the eight categories must be manufactured with a quality assurance program in place, monitored by a Commission approved quality assurance entity.

Methods for demonstrating a product's compliance with the Florida Building Code:

METHOD 1 {9B-72.040(2) and 9B-72.070(1) } Products with Code Performance Criteria and Standardized Test, or Comparative or Rational Analysis

METHOD 2 {9B-72.040(3) and 9B-72.070(2)} Products Which Have No Standardized Test, or Comparative or Rational Analysis

METHOD 1 - Products with Code Performance Criteria and Standardized Test, or Comparative or Rational Analysis using one of the following four options:

- Option A: a certification mark or listing
- Option B: a test report
- Option C: an evaluation report from an evaluation entity
- Option D: an evaluation report from an Florida Architect or Engineer

METHOD 2 - Products Which Have No Standardized Test, or Comparative or Rational Analysis using one of the following two options:

- Option A: an evaluation report from an evaluation entity
- Option B: an evaluation report from an Florida Architect or Engineer


Products Submitted with an Evaluation Report from an Evaluation Entity

- Provides verifiable documentation that the product complies with the Code.
- Product evaluation report from an approved product evaluation entity.

Products Submitted with an Evaluation Report from an a Florida Architect or Engineer



- Signed and sealed product evaluation report from a Florida Registered Architect or Florida Professional Engineer.
- Based on testing or comparative or rational analysis or a combination.
- Provides verifiable documentation that the product complies with the Code.



Local Product Approval is required for the eight categories of products. The manufacturer has the "OPTION" of seeking state approval from the Florida Building Commission.

The state has established uniform rules for the local product approval process.

Local Building Departments began using this process October 1, 2003.

Application for Local Product Approval

NOTE: The following is an example of the information to be submitted for approval by local jurisdictions.

Provide the information about the product:

- Product name and model number (if any);
- Name, address and reports of the applicable testing lab, evaluation entity, or certification agency
- List of requirements with which the product complies including Code section numbers and/or reference standards
- List of limitations on product's use
- Installation instructions for the product

- Give any other information that may be of assistance to the local jurisdiction in considering the application.
- Name and title of person authorized to sign on behalf of applicant.

Validation Checklist For Local Product Approval

Form No.: 9B-72.130(5)

- **№1.** Verify the submission and completeness of product approval application form.
- **№2.** Verify the method of demonstrating compliance is from an entity approved by the Florida Building Commission.

Local Validation Checklist (Cont.)

3. Verify submission of the evaluator's certification of independence.

Note: The evaluator may be a test lab, certification agency, evaluation entity or Florida Registered Architect or Florida Professional Engineer which produced the report.

Local Validation Checklist (Cont.)

4. Verify the method of demonstrating compliance is current and has not been suspended, recalled or revoked.

№ 5. Verify the product has not been recalled or revoked by the Florida Building Commission.

Local Validation Checklist (Cont.)

- 6. Verify the Code sections and reference standards for which the evaluation demonstrates compliance.
- ❖ 7. Verify the method of demonstrating compliance indicates any limitations on the use of the product, as intended.

Local Validation Checklist (Cont.)

8. Verify manufacturer's installation instructions are provided, if required.

9. Verify that a quality assurance program audited by a Florida Building Commission approved third party quality assurance agency is in place.

Applications for state product approval are \$300 per product sub-category.

 Each of the categories of products has been divided into sub-categories.

For example, under the category of windows, the sub-categories are awning, casement, dual action, double hung, single hung, fixed, horizontal slider, projected, pass through, mullions, wind breaker or other.

One \$300 application would cover a manufacturer's entire line under one of these subcategories.

State Validation Checklist

- 4.Verify test or evaluation report has not been recalled or revoked
 - 5.Verify evaluation complies with Code adopted standards
 - 6. Verify limitations of use are consistent with report
 - 7. Verify in stallation instructions are consistent with report
 - 8. Verify Q.A. program is audited by approved Q.A. entity
