

Obituary

GRACE HADEN PETERSON



On June 9, 2021, Grace Haden Peterson, age 100, of Palmyra, Virginia and of Fluvanna County, passed away in her home, gracefully, three days after her 100th birthday. She was the widow of Bouson E. Peterson, Sr., who was the love of her life and to whom she was very happily married for over 58 devoted years.

Grace Peterson was born on June 6, 1921, at Pleasant Grove near Palmyra, the County Seat of Fluvanna County, to the late Otis Fletcher Haden, Sr. and Annie Taylor Haden. In addition to her husband, Grace was preceded in death by her nine siblings, five brothers, Ritchie, Otis, Jr., Billy, Buddy, and Sonny; and by her four sisters, Mollie Shackelford, Virginia Lee Haney, Mary Ann Parrish, and Frances Parrish, all also born on Pleasant Grove.

In her youth, Grace and her family moved from Pleasant Grove up Virginia State Route 53 (now the Thomas Jefferson Parkway) toward Cunningham and settled on another lovely farm which was sold after Grace's beloved father's death, and which is now the "Stage Coach Hills Subdivision".

After her graduation from Fluvanna County High School and one day while fox hunting with hounds with her father in the Cunningham area, she first met Bouson, Sr., who was also an avid fox hunter, and then ensued a courtship culminating in their marriage.

After her marriage, Grace first lived for about seven years with her husband and some of his family members at what now is the "Black Family Farm" on now Hidden Valleys Road, Palmyra. While living there, the only child of Grace and Bouson, Sr. was born, namely their son, Bouson E. Peterson, Jr., who survives his mother and who lives in the town of Scottsville in Fluvanna County.

Next, the then young family of three moved only about one mile to another Fluvanna County farm, this time on Virginia State Highway No 639, now Long Acre Road, Palmyra, where Grace and her beloved husband lived and farmed the rest of their lives. Thusly, Grace lived her entire life on four (4) farms and she always proudly lived in Fluvanna County.

On "Peterson's Farm", near Antioch, she was involved in her husband's farming "industry", namely, "Peterson's Cannery", which canned various garden vegetables, especially tomatoes, and which shipped a significant quantity of canned goods overseas to Europe in support of American personnel serving during World War II.

Grace then began work as a sales clerk in the Hawkins Brothers Store on what is presently the Downtown Mall in Charlottesville, and in which she was in charge of the Boy Scout Department for 18 years. While she was still employed there, she founded a Cub Scout Den at her own home. Then, she worked another 18 years as a sales

clerk at The Hub on Valley Street in Scottsville.

Grace always relished being a "farm woman" and often hand fed and raised numerous calves which became devoted cattle to her for many years. Likewise, she loved feeding and caring for chickens, and she made many pets of them as well.

Grace loved gardening, both vegetables and flowers, especially roses, and she was famed for her prolific vegetable gardens, which she irrigated and from which she generously and delightedly shared their bounties with neighbors and friends.

Early in her marriage, Grace joined the Wesley's Chapel United Methodist Church and since she loved children, she taught the children's Sunday School class there for a number of years. Moreover, she was renowned as being very generous to generations of "Trick-or-Treaters" for many decades of Halloweens.

Grace also loved reading newspapers, especially The Daily Progress and later the Fluvanna Review as well. It was very important to her to be well informed, especially about Fluvanna County news. Because she was such a "people person," she was eager to discuss current events with her friends and neighbors.

Grace Peterson was a very avid University of Virginia sports fan and she always kept incredible track of the UVA basketball and football teams. She was especially fond of the UVA basketball players and coaches and she was a huge fan of Tony Bennett (the UVA basketball coach and not the singer). Throughout the past UVA basketball season, as well as decades of them before, on game days/nights, she would ask her son, "Don't we have a game today/tonight?" If the upcoming game was not on television, she would ardently listen to the game on the radio.

One of the leaders of the former Scottsville Volunteer Rescue Squad called Grace Peterson a "legend" among the Rescue Squad members. One summer afternoon, while clearing brush behind her house, she suffered a horrendous fall and a resulting broken hip. She was somehow able to low-crawl a very considerable distance to reach up and call on a rotary telephone the Rescue Squad for their life saving assistance.

Without the many wonderful blessings from her Lord, and without her grace, tenacity, perseverance, and resilience, Grace would not have been able to live the very long, very happy, and very productive life which she lived.

Grace will be dearly missed by her friends, her nieces and nephews, her devoted and wonderful caregivers, her caring friends from Fluvanna Meals on Wheels, and by all who knew her, including her loving and devoted son, "B.E."

Because of the life she lived and because of her many medical recoveries, many of which were assisted by the Lake Monticello Volunteer Rescue Squad, as well as the former Scottsville Volunteer Rescue Squad, Grace Haden Peterson received the well deserved nickname, "Amazing Grace".

Funeral arrangements are being handled by Thacker Brothers Funeral Home, Scottsville and services will be conducted at the Wesley's Chapel United Methodist Church on Rolling Road South near Kidds Store on Tuesday, June 15, 2021. Viewing will be from 10 a.m. – 11 a.m. in the church. The funeral service, conducted by Rev. Anthony Clore, will be at 11 a.m. Interment will immediately follow in the church cemetery.

Martha Diane (Lunsford) Graf, of Palmyra, died on June 10, 2021 and while the book on her life is closed, her prolific love of life, family and friends will never be forgotten. Diane and her surviving husband, George were a loving couple who put their relationship above all else. Walking hand-in-hand wherever they went was their romantic trademark.

Diane relished weekend jaunts in her MG Midget convertible scouring yard sales for fun trinkets. She was an avid reader of historical fiction and looked forward to the weekly trips to the county library to see the new arrivals. She was in the first graduating class of Colonial Heights High School and she graduated from Madison College when it was an all-girls school. She also took classes at UVA.

Diane taught elementary school in Charlottesville at Clark, Jackson-Via, and Burnley-Moran schools. She was much loved by her students, and it was common for a former student to approach her in public to let her know how much she meant to them. One of her proudest achievements was winning Teacher of the Year in 1991. At one time she was also the rental manager of Foxridge Apartments in Blacksburg Virginia back in the mid-1970s.

Diane lived overseas for 16 years when George was transferred with the U.S. Army. She valiantly fought four bouts of cancer and numerous surgeries since 1993. While overseas, she helped local neighbors to learn English. She adopted a few orphanages in the horn of Africa collecting and buying clothing and shoes on a monthly basis and shipped it to the orphans. While overseas, she loved cheese, crusty bread and wine picnic excursions in German and French vineyards, on the side of babbling streams, and within

blossoming gardens.

Diane was a very private person who best enjoyed quiet times with George. At the end of each day, they poured a glass of wine, sat on the porch and spent an hour to talk about their day or anything else.

Diane was predeceased by her loving parents, Henry and Marguerite Lunsford of Colonial Heights, Virginia. She was born in Newport News, Virginia on March 5, 1943 at Buxton Hospital and was the eldest of the sisters and brothers – Barbara Lunsford, Kathy Tucker (deceased), Henry Lunsford Jr., Karen Laidler and Jimmy Lunsford (deceased). Diane was also predeceased by her first child, Kelly Jean.

In addition to her husband, Diane is survived by two terrific, hard-working and caring sons, Scott (b. 1967) of Cary, North Carolina and Mike (b. 1968) of Herning, Denmark. Scott is a cattle rancher who also works as a manager for a pharmaceutical firm and Mike works as a forklift driver for a Danish firm. Grandchildren are Christopher (30), Mathias (28) and Anne-Sophie (18). Diane loved her grandchildren who she got to visit and spoil in Denmark many times while stationed overseas. Diane is also survived and kept in contact by her former husband, Dick Levy of Richmond Virginia.

Five School Board candidates vie for three seats

By the June 8 filing deadline, five candidates filed papers to run for three seats.

Incumbent Andrew Pullen is running unopposed in the Columbia district. He was elected in 2017.

Darryl Byers and Gequetta G. Murray-Key are running for the Rivanna seat which opened when Shirley Stewart decided to retire.

Eric Anderson is challenging incumbent Charles Rittenhouse for the Cunningham spot. Rittenhouse was first elected in 2013 and re-elected in 2017.

The Fluvanna Review asked each candidate to answer two questions: Why did you decide to run and what is your platform?

Pullen did not respond.

Anderson responded in an email which said he was in West Texas with unreliable access to the Internet.

Here are answers from the other candidates:

Rivanna

Why did you decide to run?

Byers: "I decided to run for election to the School Board because I got a clear sense, from speaking with parents and local families, that people are searching for a school board that listens to and represents them while focusing on what is best for the students in our county and their incredible teachers."

Murray-Key: "A good education is the key to success. As a community, many of us strive to teach our children how a good education can shape your entire future."

My record of experience in corrections demonstrates my capability as a public servant, and a manager with impact. My work as a planning commissioner demonstrates my ability to be an informed and decisive community administrator. I want to use my years of leadership and experience to help prepare the people who are the future of our community.

It is important for me to ensure that our

students explore a variety of educational opportunities and do so in a manner that is attentive to the needs of our diverse population.

I want to be a part of creating a space that allows all students, educators, support staff and the community the ability to reach their fullest potential.

I believe that I am a change that is needed and the voice that this community deserves."

What is your platform?

Byers: "My platform is simple;

1. I would like to improve communication between the Board, teachers and parents;

2. Discuss all options to move away from "teaching to tests;"

3. Assist in providing a safe and accepting learning environment for all students."

Murray-Key: "In order to improve our county's economic prosperity, civic health, and overall quality of life, we should try to achieve some shared goals in educating our young people. As a candidate for school board, I want to ensure that Fluvanna has the policies and resources needed to help us achieve our goals. My vision for Fluvanna schools includes:

Focus on Collaboration – I want to continue to build strong relationships between our schools, families, and community.

Expanding our resources - We need mental health support, technological and other necessary resources for our students, educators, and support staff; we need to ensure that we are making budget conscious decisions.

Quality staffing – We need to ensure that we attract and retain high quality educators and support staff with competitive salaries with diverse experiences."





School Board listens to mask debate, honors retirees

Masks, procedures, graduation and retiree recognition dominated the June 9 Fluvanna School Board meeting.

Chair Perry Johnson (Fork Union) started with what is usually a simple procedure of accepting the agenda, when James Kelley (Palmyra) asked to remove the vote to challenge the public schools mask mandate.

Andrew Pullen (Columbia) had earlier requested the matter be put on the agenda.

Answering Kelley's request, Johnson said in the past she asked that three members agree before putting a new item on the agenda.

Johnson said while the Chair has the right to decide what goes on the agenda, she should have followed her own protocol.

Kelley made a formal motion to withdraw the mask mandate vote.

During discussion, Johnson said she took an oath to uphold the Constitution of the United States and Virginia and did not feel comfortable voting against Governor Ralph Northam's executive order.

Northam's order for wearing masks indoors and outside in schools is set to expire June 30.

Pullen said in the past the Board sent resolutions to the Governor when they didn't agree with a ruling about the band playing on the same field as the football players and he didn't see the difference.

"We're completely taking away the parent's right to make a decision and putting it in the governor's hand," Pullen said.

The Board voted 3-2 to remove the mask action item. Pullen and Charles Ritzenhouse voted against.

Before recognizing retirees from the 2019-20 and 2020-21 school years (see sidebar) the Board heard an earful from citizens during public comments.

A vocal group of about 10, most not wearing masks nor physical distancing, clapped when someone spoke against wearing masks.

Jason Hampshire asked the Board to open graduation (graduates get six family tickets).

"You're teaching them there's no freedom in this country..," he said, adding: "Let people decide for themselves. If you're scared, stay home. No one wants you here anyway."

Jennifer Scopelliti said making someone wear a mask affects children's health, learning and psyche.

"The emotional and psychological warfare you're inflicting upon them is disgusting," she said. "...shame on you for continuing this farce. Shame on you for continuing this unimaginable situation."

Later during the meeting, Superintendent Chuck Winkler said he trusts the high

school team who worked on the graduation plans and will not change them.

However, Winkler said if anyone needs extra graduation tickets, they should call the high school and explain their need.

Brenda Gilliam, executive director for instruction and finance, gave an overview of the Fiscal Year 2020 school budget. She anticipates ending the year with about

\$1 million. Winkler said he hoped that amount will go back to the county.

Don Stribling, executive director for human resources, operations and student services reported on capital improvement plans that include football field turf replacement in the next year or so.

"The replacement cycle is 10-12 years," Stribling said.

A discussion followed about the wisdom of having artificial turf. The initial installation was about \$1 million. Stribling said replacement will be about the same.

"I don't know if I can say there is financial return on investment, however there are many times when it rained, and we've been able to have a game immediately after with no delay. You can't do that with a grass field," Stribling said.

Winkler said he was hoping to have all lights on solar before he retired (June 30)

but it's not quite there. "By next school year all should be live," Winkler said. "We're already starting to see electric (costs) drop or remain constant in the face of rising costs."

The school will provide three meals a day, five days a week to any child throughout the summer. Winkler said schools will also continue providing free Wi-Fi throughout the summer and next year.

The Board voted to make Juneteenth a paid holiday this year for staff.

All Board members thanked Winkler for his service.

Winkler said he will never forget his time in Fluvanna.

"It's been an honor and a privilege to work with you. I will ever be a FLUCO," he said. "This is my last ride with you. I implore you to work together. Put aside your political differences to work for students. If you're going to make a difference for the kids, you need to work together."

More than 65 graduating Flucos took a victory lap around Lake Monticello June 5 in a parade coordinated by the Lake Monticello Community Foundation.

This was the second time graduates paraded around the 10-mile Jefferson Drive loop before parading all the way to Fluvanna County High School. Last year the first parade was organized because COVID restrictions impacted graduation. This year Fluvanna High School Counselor Erika Morris said she heard from many parents and students who wanted to do the parade again. She said the school

would love to see the event become an annual tradition.

The parade included the graduates, Fluvanna County sheriff's vehicles, Lake Monticello police and local fire and rescue vehicles as well as several classic cars. Lake Monticello residents were joined by the proud families of the graduates on the parade route. Some Lake residents even hosted viewing parties with signs and balloons. Boaters and kayakers gathered at the Lake Monticello main dam to watch the parade from the water.


Fluvanna County High School was the host venue for the VHSL Region 3C track and field meet held on June 8. The boy's and girl's teams both turned in some outstanding performances.

The boy's team, coached by Steve Szarmach, was led by sophomore Jaden Ferguson who showed incredible versatility. Ferguson placed second in the high jump and second in the long jump, and fourth in the 200 meter sprint and fourth in the triple jump. This is a truly impressive performance by a sophomore. He will go on to compete in the state meet in all four events.

Also excelling for the boy's team was another sophomore. Addison Patchett placed fifth in the long jump and sixth in the triple jump. These performances earned him All-Region recognition. Junior Travis Morris was also All-Region in two events as he took sixth place in the 110 meter and 300 meter hurdle events. The boys' 4X100 relay team made all-Region with a fourth place finish. The team consisted of Darius Grier, Patchett, Tre Smith and Kenyon Smith. In addition to Ferguson, this relay team will go on to compete at the state meet.

The girls' team under new Coach Melanie Kennedy had even more outstanding results. They garnered three Region championships. Junior track standout Shea Hart won both the 100 meter and the 300 meter hurdle races. She won the shorter race by half a second and the longer race by a full second. These are impressive margins, in a meet of top athletes from around the entire Region. Hart was also All-Region in the high jump, and she will go to the state meet in that event. In one of the field events, the Flucos also had a region champion. Senior Amy Glowatch won the discus event, with a toss nearly a foot further than the second place finisher. The girls also had two relay teams that

were All-Region and qualified for the state meet. The 4X800 relay team consisted of Emily Smeds, Summer Craig, Skylar Solga and Sophie Farley, while the 4X400 relay team consisted of Farley, S. Solga, Tallon Solga and Smeds. Smeds, who is a senior, finished second in the grueling 3200 meter (2 mile) run and accordingly, was All-Region and will go to the state meet in that event. Farley, who is only a freshman, finished fourth in the 400 meter (1/4 mile) event and made All-Region and qualified for the state meet. In addition, Laura Hernandez was all-region in the pole vault.


