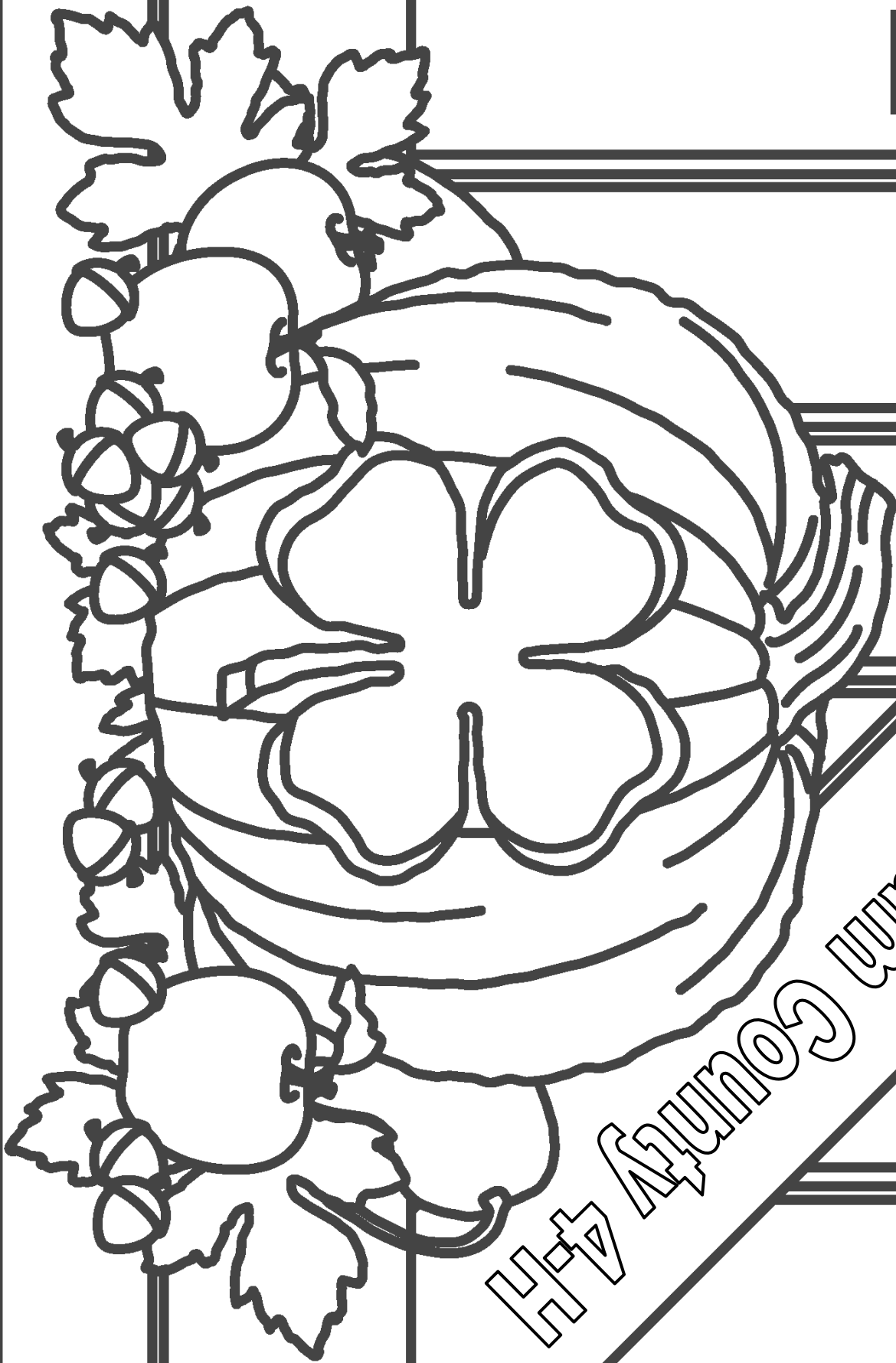

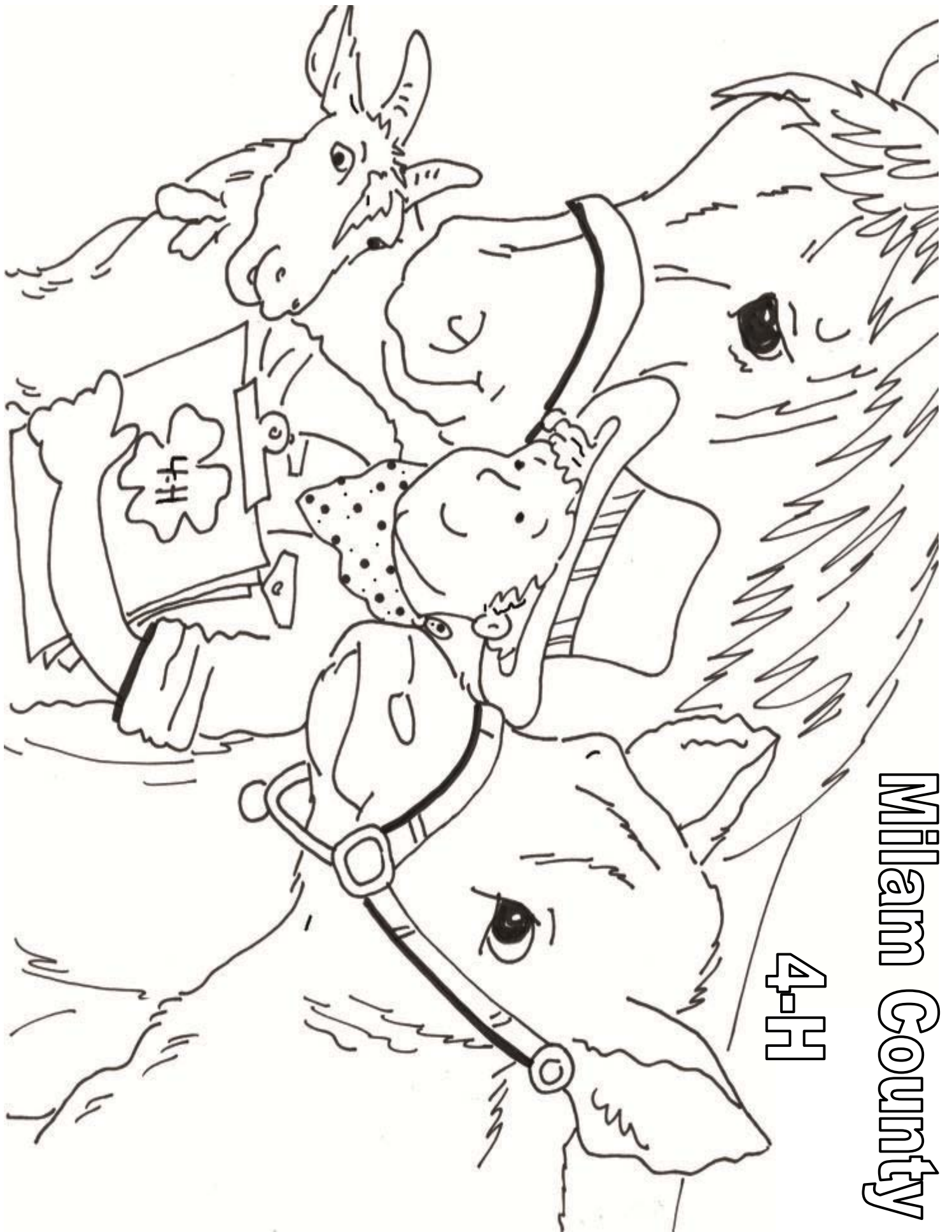
1. Open to ages K-2nd grade.
