Our loss of spouse group is about 7 individuals who have "been there, done that" and while they don't proclaim to have all the answers they have pledged to be a lending ear and can help answer questions by anyone who suddenly finds themselves in this situation. This group is on a "standby" basis so they don't have regular times they meet. They are just ready for when someone says to us "I want to talk to them and hear how they did it". There is no counselor, no therapist, no licensed social worker... just regular folks just like you that are ready to show you kindness and understanding when you may need it most. 


The Senior Center is currently looking for folks who would like to help with getting the Senior Center reaccredited over the course of this summer.






