Complete these tasks before Monday

- Create space at home for remote learning.
- Prepare your device. Make sure your device is fully charged and has access to high-speed internet. See directions for how to connect to the internet on [Chromebooks](#) and [l pads](#)
- Use your student ID number and password to log into [KCloud](#). Contact us for this information at FossilRidgeHS@kellerisd.net
- View your schedule in Aeries. Make note of the times for each class or [download the bell schedule](#). We will continue to follow the [Odd/Even calendar](#).
- From KCloud, access My Backpack to view which online classroom your teacher will use. (Google Classroom or Canvas). Your teacher will post Zoom times and links in the virtual classroom. Prepare for the virtual meetings 5-10 minutes before the scheduled time. Make sure to use your full name in Zoom.



Communication

Communication: Students will communicate with teachers through daily live lessons, emails, and/or their Google Classroom or Canvas.

- Students can message teachers in their virtual classroom or through email.
- Teachers will provide directions on how to view their virtual classroom as a parent.
- Individual assignment grades will be available in Aeries.



Student Expectations

Schedule & Instruction: Students are required to engage in learning for each class daily. Daily attendance will be recorded.

- Remote learning will follow our typical daily schedule.
- Students will receive daily “live” instruction from teachers at the beginning of each class period.
- Students will complete on demand lessons and activities in Google Classroom or Canvas. These may include recorded videos, textbook & reading assignments, graded activities, and/or quizzes.
- Students who are not available to engage in lessons and activities during the regular school day will need to notify the teacher to submit assignments by 11:59 pm.
- Behave as you would in your class:
 - Dress appropriately
 - Use appropriate language when speaking and in the chat.
 - Participate and take notes as needed.
- Zoom Discipline
 - If a student violates the student code of conduct during a zoom then they will have consequences: Private message - Parent contact - Removal from zoom - Discipline Referral - Extended asynchronous lessons.
- All students will have an allotted lunchtime from 12:55 - 1:25 PM each day.
