


# Welcome to the Coloplast<sup>®</sup> Professional Foundation Course in Stoma Care


# The Foundation Course comprises of a 4-hour online training programme which covers:

- The psychological, emotional and lifestyle issues stoma patients experience and practical tips on how to manage them

Following completion of the e-learning course, a practical workshop will be arranged in your local area for you to attend and participate in.

#### How do I get started?

If you are a Healthcare Assistant or work within Social care and do not have the support or access to a Stoma Care Nurse, please complete the registration process and select 'No supporting Nurse' option from the drop-down list.

# Information for supporting nurses




