In alignment with our By-Laws, I'm officially informing membership of specific proposed changes to Article VII. These proposed changes are to assist the club with retaining and maintaining our tax-exempt status with the IRS. The proposed changes can be found in red below. The changes will be voted for approval by the general membership at the September meeting.

Article VII - Officers

E. The Treasurer shall handle all moneys collected and disbursed by G.C.C.M., which will be deposited in the bank within five (5) business days under the name of G.C.C.M. The Governing Board shall approve the bank. The signature on the checks and withdrawals will be of the Treasurer, President, or Vice-President. The Treasurer will submit a report monthly of all financial transactions. The treasurer will also be required to file the form 990N with the IRS before April 1st each year to maintain the club's Non-Profit status.

F. When the new Treasurer takes office, the out-going Treasurer shall prepare, and the in-coming Treasurer shall accept, a complete and accurate statement of financial conditions of the Club, which shall be open for inspection to all

members. The outgoing treasurer will train the new treasurer on all treasurers' duties.
