



Fox members will be piloting this piece for Jennifer before she teaches it at the 2018 ANG seminar in Washington, D.C. Float into the distance in a hot air balloon soaring through the skies as you stitch along for the ride. A versatile and appealing design to recall lazy and carefree summer days.



"Diamond City Lights" Diane Herrmann Saturday, June 23 and Sunday, June 24, 2018 Saturday, July 7 and Sunday, July 8, 2018

Fox members will be piloting this piece for Diane before she teaches it at the 2018 ANG seminar in Washington, D.C. Glittering at sunset, the buildings on the city's lakefront light up as the sky goes dark. This study in diaper patterns will include lessons on making and compensating diaper patterns, establishing proper perspective, using single strand thread to create the sunset sky, and making stitch and thread selections to create reflections in water.



"Star Dance" Margaret Bendig Saturday, October 6 and Sunday, October 7, 2018

This piece is a study in the difference in the use of a single color using different threads, stitches, direction of stitches and the reflection of light on these stitches. The center star is a revolving set of patterns with metallic threads to add to the definition of the stitches. The background of the design is composed of many different star patterns using two values of blue silk with the addition of Sparkle Rays.

She teaches needlework throughout the country and in Canada, in shops in California and Arizona as well as for EGA Region Seminars and ANG National Seminars. Although she loves all needlework, her focus is on counted thread techniques and counted canvas designs.
