

Dear Friends,

Today we come to the high point of our Easter celebration, the Feast of Pentecost. Pentecost, meaning "fifty days" after the Passover -- was the feast day in which the Jewish people celebrated the Giving of the Law on Mount Sinai. Whenever human beings forget how limited we are and try to take the initiative in our dealings with God, what inevitably follows is disaster. An example is the story of the Tower of Babel that we are told in Gen 11 where human beings decided to build a tower that would reach to heaven.

Does the story of Babel remind you of the story we read today from the Acts of the Apostles, the disciples of Jesus speaking in other languages? Actually, the two stories are related. But Pentecost is not a repeat of Babel, Pentecost is a reversal of Babel, and this for three reasons:

- 1.At Babel human beings decided to build a tower to God by their own effort; at Pentecost it is now God who decides to build a bridge to humans by sending the Holy Spirit. Babel was a human initiative, a human effort, Pentecost is a divine initiative, a divine activity through the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Babel was a requiem of misunderstanding; Pentecost is a chorus of mutual understanding. The miracle of Pentecost is very different from the miracle of Babel. At Babel, the people came together with one language, understanding themselves. After God's intervention they dispersed no longer understanding each other. At Pentecost, on the other hand, people of different ethnic backgrounds came together unable to communicate, but after the miracle of Pentecost, they said, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? How is it that we hear them, each of us in our own language?" (Acts 2:7-8).
- 3. Finally, Pentecost differs from Babel in its result. Babel resulted in the disintegration of the human family into different races and nationalities. Pentecost, on the other hand, brings all peoples together and reunifies them under one universal family. On Pentecost we celebrate the birthday of the Church. Today is, therefore, an opportunity to rededicate ourselves to be active and faithful members of this family of God we call Church.

From Our Bishop: In light of those positive realities, it is time to remove the "General Dispensation" from the obligation to come to Mass each week. This will take effect on the Solemnity of Pentecost, one week from today, on the weekend of May 22-23, 2021. At that time, the normal expectations regarding the practice of our Faith will once again be in effect, which includes the obligation to participate, in-person, in the celebration of Holy Mass each weekend for all who are able to do so. Of course, if a person is unable to do so, due to sickness or other serious risks or concerns, the obligation does not apply; that person is dispensed by virtue of his or her particular circumstances.

Update on Masks

On Friday, May 14, 2021, the MDHHS (Michigan Department of Health and Human Services) updated its Gatherings and Mask order to align with CDC guidelines which state: "fully vaccinated people no longer need to wear a mask or physically distance in any setting, except where required by federal, state, local, tribal, or territorial laws, rules, and regulations, including local business and workplace guidance."

In light of this development, and taking into account the growing numbers of people becoming fully vaccinated and/or having the access to vaccinations; we are making the following changes to liturgical worship at Parishes effective immediately:

Parishioners are not required to wear masks for indoor worship. However, those that are unvaccinated are asked to continue to wear their masks, for their own protection as well as the protection of others.

NOTE: Please communicate this pastorally with the understanding that some Parishioners will also want to continue wearing a mask even if they do fall into exempt categories. Clergy and altar servers are asked to continue to wear masks. Anyone assisting with Holy Communion must also wear a mask. Ushers/Parish staff are NOT to ask any parishioner and /or attendee what their vaccination status is.


