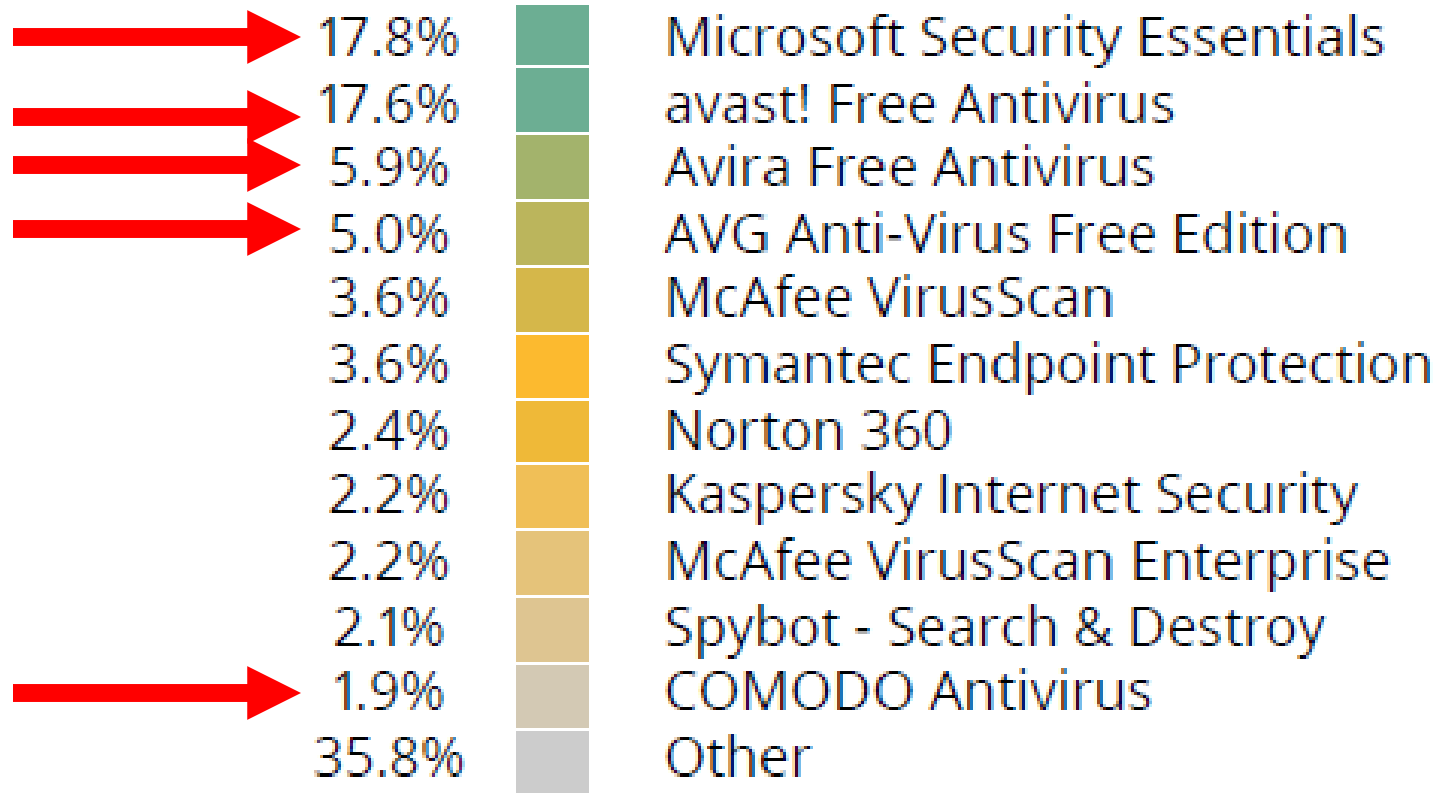

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS

- Here are 9 "must have" criterion for selecting a free antivirus program.

With the exception of "Criteria 9", we usually do not recommend antivirus products that do not meet all 9 of these criterion:

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- **Criteria 1:**
Program does memory-resident real-time scanning in the background at all times whenever the computer is powered on. This constant scanning does not have to be initiated by the end user.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- **Criteria 2:**
Program has the highest detection rate relative to other free antivirus programs.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- "Criteria 2" acknowledges that there is always a percentage or a fraction of a percent of extant viruses and malware that a specific antivirus program cannot detect at any given point in time. (= "zero day" threat)

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- **Criteria 3:**
Program does not significantly slow down the computer and reduce the productivity of the end user.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- "Criteria 3" is dependent upon how much RAM a specific computer has AND how fast of a microprocessor chip and motherboard that a computer has.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- **Criteria 4:**
Program allows manual quick scans that are initiated by the end user.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- **Criteria 5:**
Program allows manual full scans that are initiated by the end user.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- **Criteria 6:**
Program gets updates at least once per day so that the program can detect and remove new viruses that are generated as soon as possible after they are released "into the wild".

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- Criteria 7:
Program can safely quarantine infected files
so that you can do further analysis on them
and
so that you can restore quarantined files to your computer's hard drive, if the detection turns out to be a "false positive".

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- **Criteria 8:**
Program has a low rate of "false positives" so that it is not constantly alarming the end-user

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- **Criteria 9:**
Program is not dependent on having a good, solid, fast Internet connection.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- We sometimes ignore "Criteria 9" for Web-dependent antivirus products such as "Immunit Free Antivirus" when a computer resides in a location where there is a good solid, fast Internet connection at all times.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- Nice to have by not totally necessary:
Program can automatically perform quick and/or full scans on a daily, weekly, or monthly schedule as determined by the end user.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- Nice to have by not totally necessary:
No or a minimum amount of marketing emails exhorting the end-user to upgrade to a non-free version of the antivirus program.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- Nice to have by not totally necessary:
No registration period or as long of a registration period as possible so that the end-user can spend as little time as possible on marketing email (spam) and re-registering the antivirus program.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTING ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- Nice to have by not totally necessary:
Program proactively does Web filtering to block browser access to URLs that point to malware files (instead of letting you access/download the files and then deciding that the files are malware).

COMPARISON TESTS OF ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- AV-Test of Germany publishes detection percentages for "Windows.." computers but they do not test "FortiClient Endpoint Protection" (probably because "FortiNet" did not pay their testing fee).

COMPARISON TESTS OF ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- ISCA Labs, a subsidiary of Verizon that is located Pennsylvania.

They test the "FortiGate" server but they do not test the "Forticlient Endpoint Protection" software program.

The Fortinet server is for large organizations.

COMPARISON TESTS OF ANTIVIRUS PROGRAMS (continued)

- West Coast Labs in Newport Beach, California does not test "FortiClient Endpoint Protection" (probably because "FortiNet" did not pay their testing fee).

"MICROSOFT SECURITY ESSENTIALS" (continued)

- This End User License Agreement also states:
"The software may not be used on devices owned by government or academic institutions."

1. INSTALLATION AND USE RIGHTS.

- a. **Home Use.** If you are a home user, then you may install and use any number of copies of the software on your personal devices for use by people who reside in your household.
- b. **Small Business.** If you operate a small business, then you may install and use the software on up to ten (10) devices in your business.
- c. **Restrictions.** The software may not be used on devices owned by government or academic institutions.

- Since April 8, 2014, you cannot install "Microsoft Security Essentials" into a "Windows XP" computer (so install "Avast! Free Antivirus" instead).

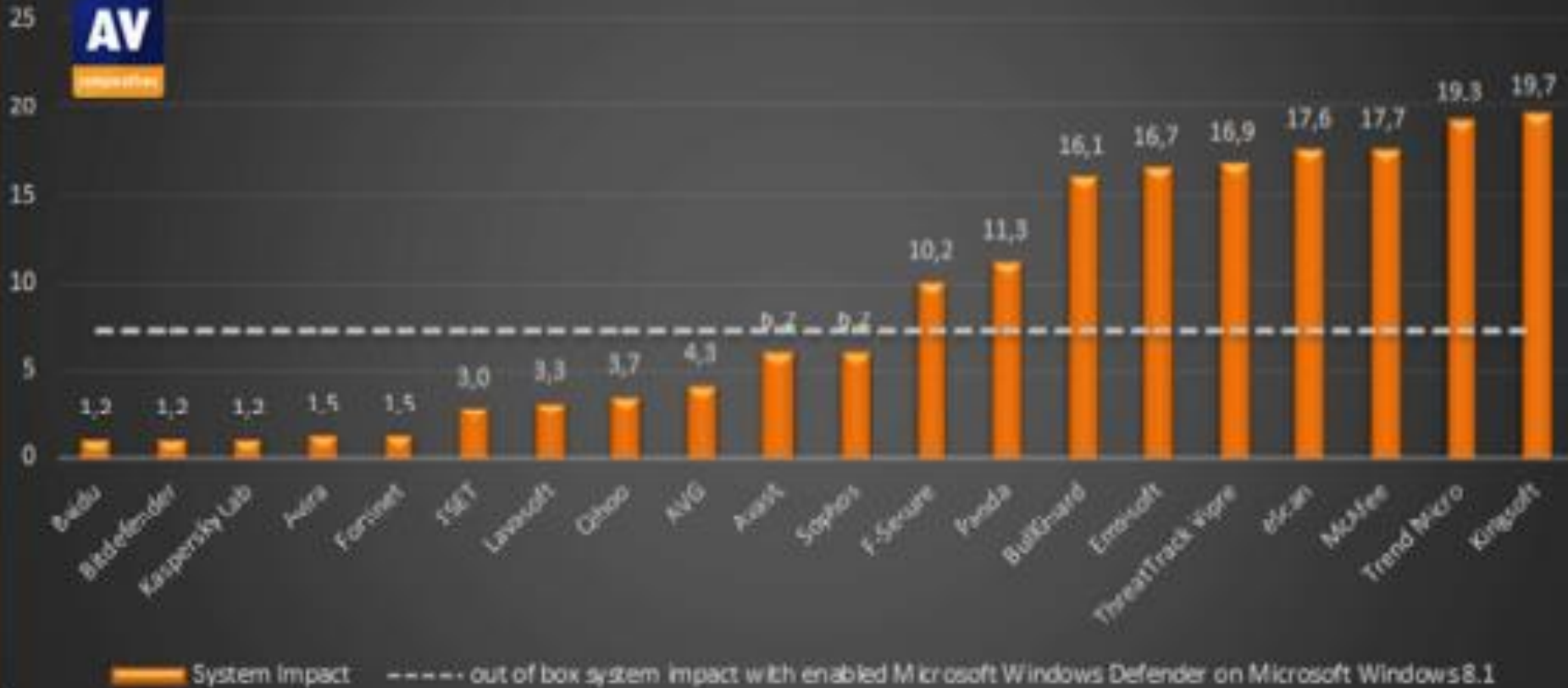

GENERIC STEPS FOR INSTALLING A FREE ANTIVIRUS PROGRAM

- Step 1:
Remove any existing installed antivirus program that has memory-resident, real-time, always-on scanning in the background (with the exception of "Malwarebytes Premium" which gets along with all other antivirus programs).

GENERIC STEPS FOR INSTALLING A FREE ANTIVIRUS PROGRAM

- Step 1 (continued):
If any existing antivirus program misbehaves and will not let you remove it, see "Removing Misbehaving Antivirus Programs" in the next section of this "how to" document.

GENERIC STEPS FOR INSTALLING A FREE ANTIVIRUS PROGRAM (continued)

- Step 2:
Reboot the computer to make sure that any antivirus programs that you removed in "Step 1" are removed from memory ("RAM").

- Step 3:
Reboot the computer to make sure that any antivirus programs that you removed in "Step 1" are removed from memory ("RAM").

Download the installation file for the desired antivirus program.

Ignore any attempts by the installation program to sell you an upgrade.

- Step 14:
Start each of your Web browser programs and make sure that the installation process of the antivirus program did not modify the default "search provider". If it did, set it back to the "search provider" that you want to have as a default.

- Step 15:
Start up the newly-installed
antivirus program.
- Step 16:
Run a "Quick Scan".
- Step 17:
Run a "Full Scan".
