



2016 TAX TIPS FROM CH ACCOUNTING & TAX

Do you use Public Transit?

You can claim cost of monthly public transit passes or passes of longer duration such as an annual pass for travel within Canada on public transit for 2016!

These passes must allow unlimited travel, and includes local buses & local ferries.

You can also claim the cost of Short-term passes if each pass entitles you to unlimited travel for at least 5 consecutive days; and you buy enough of these passes for unlimited travel for at least 20 days in any 28-day period.

You can also claim the cost of Electronic payment cards if the card is used to make at least 32 one-way trips over a maximum of 31 consecutive days; and the card is issued by a public transit authority that records and provides a receipt for the cost and usage of the card.

Note that individual ride or trip passes are not eligible for this credit as they do not provide for unlimited travel.

This is a very specific deduction, but it does allow you to claim transportation to & from work under these circumstances, so it's suggested to use the credit!





Pitbull – "Climate Change"
There's no denying the fact that
Armando Christian Pérez is a
master of self-promotion, not a
bit shy about his persona, and
onstage he's high on bravado
and low on modesty-but Pitbull
is also a master at reading

t r e n d s , r e c o r d i n g catchy tunes and giving us p o p / d a n c e songs that are still standing the test of time in a genre of music



This is Pitbull's tenth album and it opens with a very familiar refrain as Calgary's own Kiesza sings the chorus of Pat Benatar's "Love Is A Battlefield" on the song "We Are Strong". This is a great example of how Pitbull knows that the best thing you can do is stretch your songs to include great vocalists-and let them do what they do best. This is a fantastic song. That formula works so well as Flo Rida and LunchMoney Lewis take the track "Greenlight" over the top and propel it into the pop-hit stratosphere.

To crank things up even more Pitbull bangs out "Sexy Body" with Jennifer Lopez-this track is pure old-school dance, complete with a 90's vibe that still sounds fresh and Contemporary. I can see this one being a big hit.

If that wasn't enough he gets Travis Baker (Blink 182) to pound out the beats as Robin Thicke provides chorus vocals and Joe Perry of Aerosmith bends the strings on the retrosounding chant along number "Bad Man". Enrique Iglesias joins Pitbull with a vocal sample from REO Speedwagon's "Take It On The Run" for the track "Messin' Around". It's great to hear unexpected samples in modern pop/dance songs done this well. Again, another great track.

Bob Marley's son Stephen joins Pitbull on the mellow "Options"

(it's an o.k. song) but if I had to pick one track as the best here I would have to say it's "Better On Me", as rapper Ty Dollah \$ign sings in a

wonderfully rough voice on what is a great EDM song with a lot of heart and soul-something that is not common in a lot of EDM numbers. Other songs have guest appearances by Leona Lewis and Jason DeRulo but it's R. Kelly and Austin Malone's vocal skills that help make "Dedicated" stand out as such a great track.

Pitbull pushes the boat out even more as American DJ/producer Eric Alberto-Lopez (known professionally as Ape Drums) and vocalist Stephen A. Clark close off the album with "Can't Have", a song that is creative and unique. Ape Drums is known for fusing electronic dance music with Caribbean sounds, described as "Modern Dancehall Music" but this song pretty much defies categorization-it is great. There might be a day where Pitbull's music is no longer relevant, or enjoyable but judging by this album, that day is a long

way off.
