

Frida Kahlo Webquest

- This learning experience will have two parts. The WebQuest will get us looking and thinking about the art of Frida Kahlo. The second part of this lesson will be creating a self-portrait. You will need to draw yourself, a pet (or your dream pet), and a background that tells us about who you are.

Paso #7: Tu autorretrato

- **a symbolic background(s)**

Frida often used lush vegetation in the background of her portraits to represent her connectedness with nature.

- **a symbolic animal(s)**

Choose an animal that can be used to symbolize you in some way. Frida used pets to represent her surrogate children or to symbolize characteristics like tenderness.

- **a personal feature**

Frida often exaggerated her eyebrows and hair in her artwork. Her hair was a sign of her femininity.
