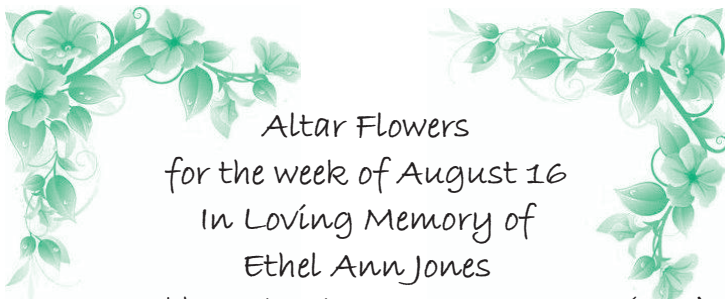
At the conference they presented to us seven traits of an amazing parish:

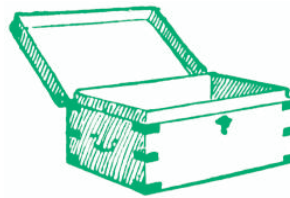
