From the Vocation Director... Sister Sarah Elizabeth Roy

In Luke 5:4 Jesus said, "Put out into the deep water and let down your nets for a catch." Vocation work is just that, "casting" ourselves out there and trusting God to provide us with a catch of wonderful women who will continue to bring God's compassionate presence to others.

Where have we been casting our nets lately?

- At the FOCUS Conference (Fellowship of Catholic University Students) held in Orlando, Florida. 4,000 college students attended this conference.
- At the NRVC Conference (National Religious Vocation Conference) in Plano, Texas. This gathering of vocation directors throughout the United States was an opportunity for training and networking.
- At Peoria Notre Dame High School, teaching about early Church communities and the founding of religious life.
- In providing women with opportunities to schedule a visit with our community. Two women are presently spending time getting to know us to discern their call to our community.
- In welcoming a young woman from Macomb, IL into our affiliation program (the first step towards entrance into the community).
- In welcoming a young woman into postulancy (the first official step of the formation process).
- In the VISION online matching service (a dating service for religious communities and discerners). Making contact with these women and sending them information about our community and scheduling visits with them.

As you can see, we are casting our nets far and wide in order to allow God to fill them with women committed to serving His kingdom. Thank you for your prayers and support in making this ministry possible.

y connection with Sister Mary Esther goes back 57 years to kindergarten when she was my teacher at Sacred Heart School in Moline. I am sure that the good start that Sister Mary Esther gave me and her good example led me to become both a sister in the same community and a teacher like her. I saw her great love for her Pavich family as well as her love for her fellow sisters. I saw her willingness to give her all to whatever ministry she was assigned whether it be cook, teacher, catechist, tutor, secretary, visiting with the elderly, sacristan, laundress and in these last years, full-time prayer and support. She was never afraid of hard work. Sister Mary Esther did all of these ministries with joy and graciousness. She had a good sense of humor, liked to tease, and was always up for a good time. She was a wonderful example of kindness, hospitality and friendliness to all who came her way.

I share with you today a poem written for her at the time of her Golden Jubilee by her sisterin-law, Helen Pavich. (excerpt) She has devoted her life to others

Her talents too many to count She has touched the lives of hundreds No problem too great to surmount.... For fifty years it has been "Sister" It's herself that she has given to all. "Dear Sister we salute, as you celebrate That day when you answered the 'Call.'"

sister Mary Ruth spent her life squeezing out all the song and dance, laughter and joy, goodness and grace, which God's great Gift of Life offers us all. She found joy everywhere and in everything.

She truly had the heart of a child, having taught little children for most of her life in ministry. I'm sure that she learned from them as well... She helped God unstop the ears of the deaf when she played the piano for the people at St. Joseph's Home of Springfield – and for all of us. She taught children in kindergarten to move with the music ... Her parents nurtured her love for music at an early age as they encouraged her to play the accordion for Belgian gatherings in Moline.

And how she loved her family! She was so happy in the times that she shared meals with them and visited with them. She especially took pleasure in the children as they grew and enjoyed showing off her family pictures. She had a special love for her ancestral home in Belgium and the Flemish language.

But most of all, Sister Mary Ruth loved her Lord. She was not overly demonstrative or particularly "religious" in her devotion, but simple and straightforward about it. As I sat next to her in her last hours on this earth I asked her to entreat the Lord for all her dear sisters – to give us a double portion of her spirit of Joy and Gladness in the Lord.

Sister Mary Stephanie made her final vows on August 20, 1948, and was appointed housemother for the big girls at Guardian Angel Home. Because of my family situation, it was in August of 1948 that I appeared at GAO. I was an 8th grader, a big girl and Sister Stephanie became my mother. Sister's loving, caring presence, was always there for us as we worked or played; comforting us, encouraging us, providing after-school snacks, being "mother" 24/7.

She took pride in our appearance, like a mother does... She taught us how to cook, how to decorate, how to make something beautiful out of something very simple. Through the example of her Belgian work ethic we learned responsibility, pride in work well done, and the importance of caring for others.

We all appreciated Sister's eye for beauty and her talent for decorating for holidays, feast days, birthdays, for any excuse – just to make others happy. Sister Stephanie was blessed with many

talents – gifts that she joyfully shared with all of us. The list of her ministry assignments is testimony to this: cook, housemother, housekeeper, teacher, nursing home wing supervisor, office assistant and gift shop manager. And those of us who have lived with her know that this list does not begin to include the countless ways Sister quietly performed behind-thescenes services to help make life easier for the Sisters.

Sister Stephanie, thank you for the blessing you have been in my life!
