C.U.R.V.E.

C.U.R.V.E. Before and After School Program Ages 4-12

Community Center – C.U.R.V.E. Room

The Hazel Crest Park District's C.U.R.V.E. provides a structured, before and after school program, for children attending Hazel Crest School Districts #144 and #152 ½. This program includes transportation to and from school. First-time registration will require the completion of participant forms and proof of residency. Forms of residency accepted are a valid driver's license, utility bill and mortgage/rental agreements.

Please note that monthly registration is required each month and must be received on or before the 5th of every month with full payment. Registrations received after the 5th of the month will be accessed a \$10 late charge. Monthly registration is also required for those families who receive financial assistance from the State of Illinois. A \$100 per child co-payment is also due at time of registration. This fee is required to subsidize our daily rates not fully reimbursed by the state and administrative costs associated with accepting state assistance.

A non-refundable, one-time registration fee of \$30.00 is due each school year. The program schedule includes homework time and assistance (if during time allotted for homework, your child does not complete it, we are not responsible), crafts and activities and recreation time at our gym and aerobics room.

Before School: 6:30am to Start of School Children must arrive by 7:15am for District #152½ and by 7:30am for District #144 to ensure on-time drop-offs for the beginning of school.

After School:End of School -- 6:00pmA late fee of \$2 per minute will be accessed beginning at 6:05pm according to our clock setting. Allparents must contact the CURVE program at 708.335.1500, Ext. 127 to report any late pick-up.

Completion of a Summer Camp Packet is required for all families, even if currently enrolled in C.U.R.V.E. For those parents who attend, you will receive the waiver of the required \$30 per family registration fee. Further, this meeting will allow parents to address any questions, concerns, payment, unique child situations and any questions you may have. This important meeting will allow you to meet Hazel Crest Park District staff that will lead to a positive experience for all campers!


