

#### BLM Emergency Closure of Clear Creek Management Area (CCMA) Effective May 1, 2008

The EPA released a report, "CCMA Asbestos Exposure and Human Health Risk Assessment," stating the exposure measured by the EPA for many recreational activities at CCMA are "above the EPA acceptable risk range for lifetime cancers. Based on the findings in this report, the BLM issued an immediate temporary closure of 31,000 acres of area to all public access/entry.
